Notes and Reminders

Happy November! As we begin to prepare for the Christmas season in just a few weeks, let's take a look at why Jesus' birth was so important. This month, our 2- and 3-year old classes will be learning about God's promise to save the world from sin.

OUTLINE



Arrival/Attendance/ Directed Play

8:55-9:10

Welcome the children and mark them as present on the attendance sheet on the clipboard by the door. Set up the activities and introduce the children to the lesson through these activities. Encourage the kids to participate in both activities as they play together. Feel free to set up additional activities from your room, such as play dough, puzzles, games, or toys!

Color Sort

- Spread out the rainbow dots on a table. Place the mixed bag of pom-poms in the middle of the table with several pairs of tweezers. Encourage the children to use the tweezers to move the pom-poms to the dot of the same color. Be sure to help children take turns. If all of the pom-poms get sorted, place them back in the bag, shake them up, and begin again!
- SAY You all did a great job matching the pom-poms to their colors! Sometimes the colors were just a little bit different, but they were all still pom-poms! We are going to read a story today that teaches us how God made us all different. He made us all special and loves us for the ways we are different from each other!

Our Puzzle

- Give each child a blank puzzle piece to color. As children finish coloring, use a small piece of tape to tape the piece on the wall and place them together to make a completed puzzle.
- SAY I love all of the puzzle pieces you made today. Our puzzle looks so unique with all of your pieces put together! Just like all of your puzzle pieces are different, God made us different too. When we all work together, we are beautiful, just like our puzzle!





Clean Up and Gather for Story

9:10-9:15

Invite the children to begin cleaning up toys and putting away their activities at 9:10. Then remind them to meet at the carpet for Bible story time. Remind the children that we are going to do our best to be good listeners.

Bible Story

9:15-9:30

Welcome Song

- Welcome all the children by singing their welcome song
- (Tune of Twinkle Twinkle Little Star)
- Welcome, Welcome Everyone
- Now you're here Let's have some fun
- First let's clap our hands like so
- Then reach down and touch our toes
- Welcome, Welcome Everyone
- Now you're here Let's have some fun
 - You can call a group of children names to welcome them and they can stand up and wave if you'd like.

This week, we will be reading "God's Very Good Idea" by Tricia Newbell. Focus on helping the children to understand that God made them! He made them special and loves them for how they are all different. Listed below are some ideas of questions you could ask the children as you read through the book and questions you may use to review at the end of the book. If you are viewing this document online, there is a scanned version of the book on pages 7-11.

Questions to ask as you read

- Page 1/2: How many of you have ever had a good idea? (Raise hands)
 - Page 3/4: Who are some people that you love?
 - Page 5/6: what differences do you see in this picture?
 - Page 7/8: Which of you are boys, or young men? (Raise hands) Which of you are girls. or young women? (Raise hands) This is one way God made you special!
 - Page 9/10: Who likes when someone reads you a book? Who likes to ride bikes or play outside?
 - Page 11/12: Who in our class has curly hair? Who has straight hair? What are some hair colors that you can see?
 - Page 13/14: What does it mean to be valuable? It means that something is really important!
 - Page 15/16: Why can we love God and love each other? Because of Jesus!
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Review Questions

- What was God's very good idea? He made all of us!
- What are some ways God made all of us special? (Answers may vary)
- What does it mean if something is valuable? It is really important!
- What does Jesus help us do? Love God and love each other

SAY God knew we were so valuable that he made us all different! We are all special and loved by God because he made us. When people didn't love God, he knew we needed Jesus to show us how to love him and love each other! Because Jesus showed us how he loves God and loves each of us, we can follow his example!

Craft/Coloring Page

9:30-9:40

After the story, have the children go to their tables and prepare for a craft to go along with the lesson. Our **BIG IDEA** of the week is: God Promised to Save Us.

Distribute the "God Sent His Son to Save the World" craft sheet. Encourage the children to color the globe with blue and green crayons. When they are done coloring, help each child to glue a cross cutout to their page, over the world.

As children finish, distribute the coloring page with the Creation story on the back for children to continue coloring. Have the children place both the craft and coloring sheet in their bin when they are finished.

Friends from Afar

9:40-9:50

You will find today's activity for Friends from Afar in the Binder on the counter. The information for this month's Global Partner family and an activity to learn about where they are serving are included. Necessary supplies are located in your bin.





Songs/Memory Verse/Prayer

9:50-10:05

There is a list of songs for today's lesson on the TV. Use the directions located with the remote to access them.

Prayer (Use these words, or your own, to pray about today's Bible lesson. Take time to listen to prayer requests from the children and pray for them as well!)

- Dear God, Thank you for making each one of us. We thank you that you knew it was good for each of us to be different and special. We pray that you help us see how Jesus loves everyone around us and help us to love them too! In your Name we pray, Amen.

Memory Verse

- "God sent his son to save the world." John 3:17
- Teach the children the motions for this verse
 - God- Point up
 - sent- point forward
 - his son- lay your hand over your heart
 - to save- make an 'X' with your arms across your chest
 - the world- make a circle with your hands
 - John 3:17- Make a 3 with your fingers
- Have the children joining you in saying the verse and doing the motions several times to practice. Ask the children if anyone would like to do the verse on their own. If someone needs help, have them pick a friend or do it with them. If no one volunteers, repeat as a class twice more.

Snack Time at Tables

10:05-10:15

Prior to serving the snack have the children use hand sanitizer before choosing a seat at the table. Each child will have veggie straws on a napkin and a small cup of water. **NOTE:** some children with allergies will have their own snack or drink...parents usually remind shepherds of this at drop off. If a question, please contact Kid Min Staff in hallways. Thanks.

While the children are eating their snack, please read the read aloud book that is in the bin labeled Read Aloud book for snack time. Thanks.





Free Choice Play

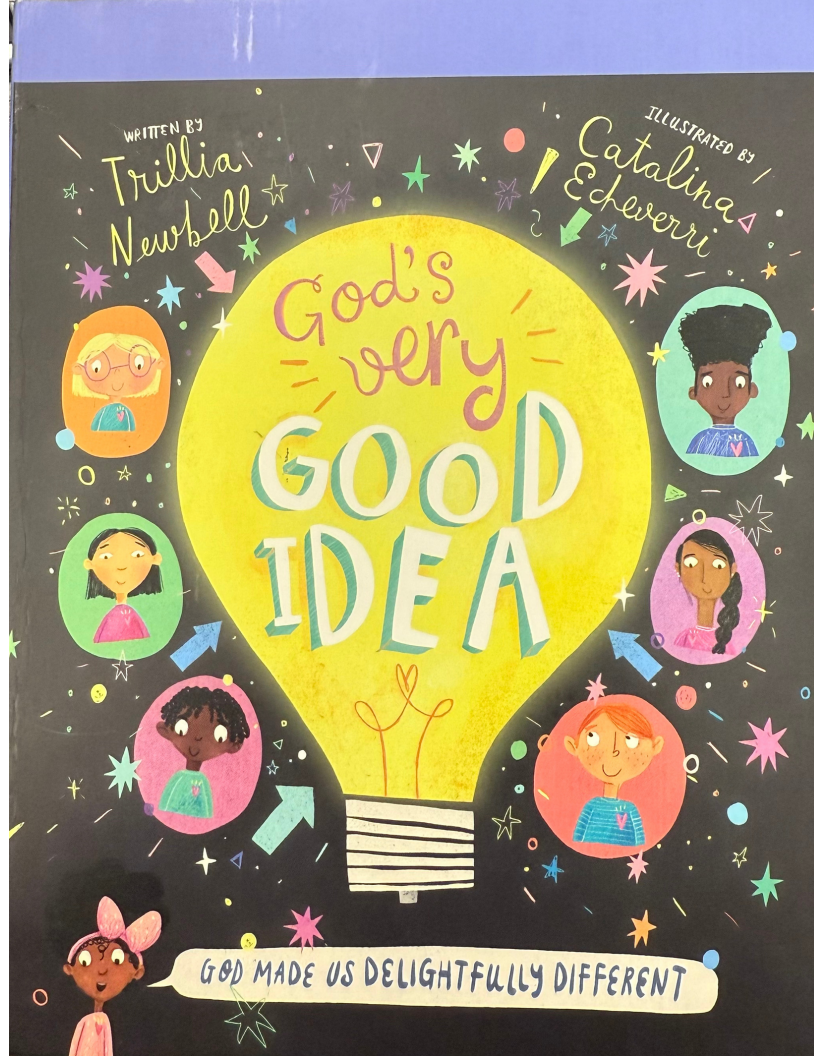
10:15-10:40

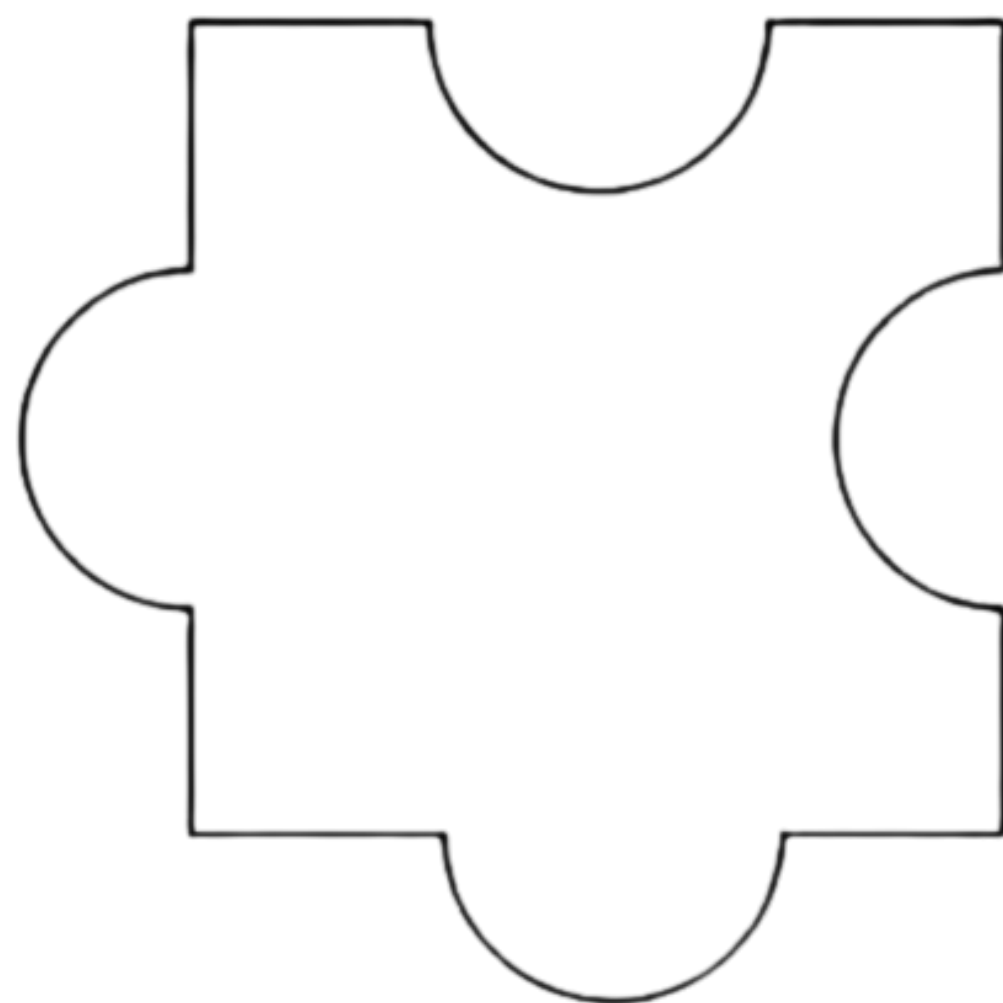
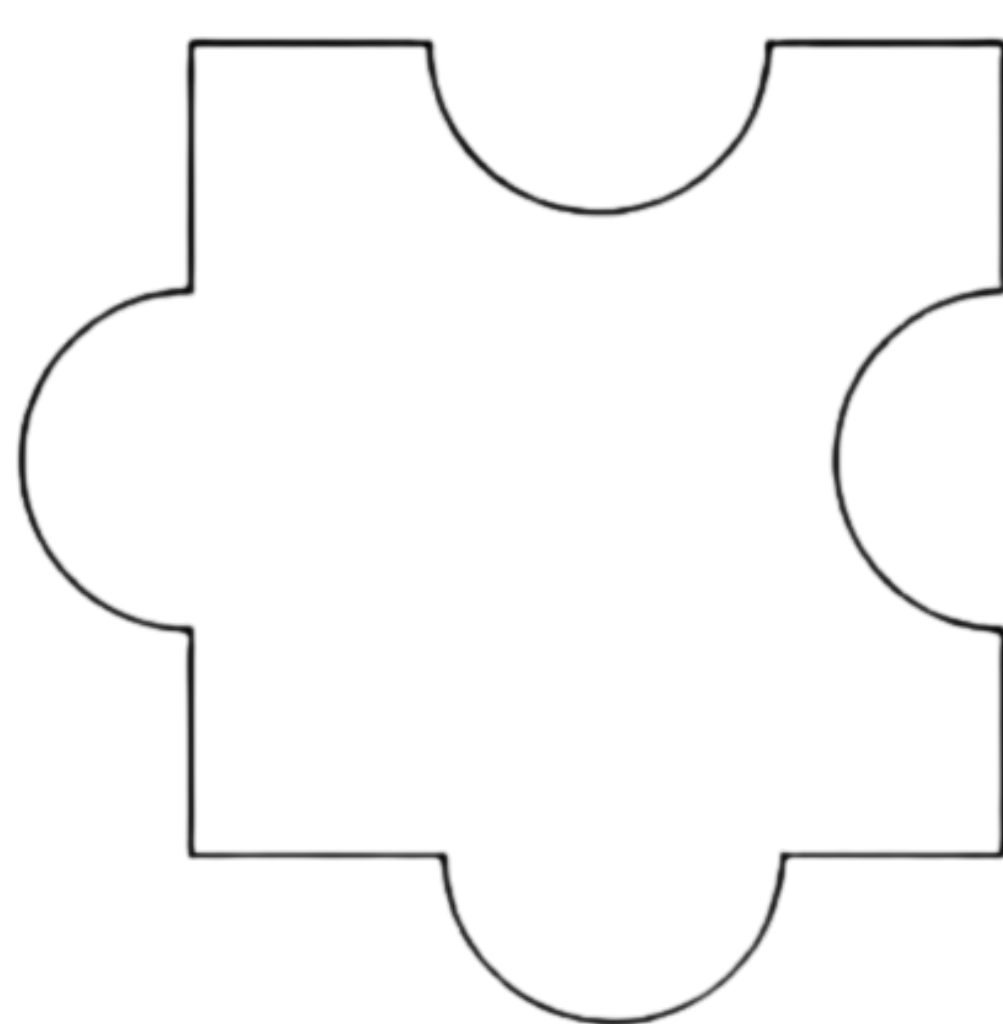
