#### **Notes and Reminders**

Happy November! As we begin to prepare for the Christmas season in just a few weeks, let's take a look at why Jesus' birth was so important. This month, our 2- and 3-year old classes will be learning about God's promise to save the world from sin.

## **OUTLINE**

### Arrival/Attendance/ Directed Play

10:40-11:05

Welcome the children and mark them as present on the attendance sheet on the clipboard by the door. Set up the activities and introduce the children to the lesson through these activities. Encourage the kids to participate in both activities as they play together. You may need to ask the kids to come to the different areas so all of them have the opportunity to participate.

#### Love Box

- Hide the laminated hearts in the red sensory bins in your room. as the children find the hearts, read the phrase written on it out loud, then have the children repeat it with you.
- SAY Wow friends! These hearts remind me of how much God loves us! We discovered so many hearts that tell us how God loves us so much. Our Bible story today will show us how God loves us most!

#### Sing Jesus Loves Me

- Teach the children the words to this song and encourage them to sing it with you. If you know motions, you may also teach them the motions to do as you sing!
  - O Jesus loves me, this I know.
  - o for the Bible tells me so.
  - Little ones to him belong;
  - they are weak, but he is strong.
  - Yes, Jesus loves me! Yes, Jesus loves me!
  - Yes, Jesus loves me! The Bible tells me so.

Clean Up and Gather for Story

11:05-11:10

Invite the children to begin cleaning up toys and putting away their activities at 9:10. Then remind them to meet at the carpet for Bible story time. Remind the children that we are going to do our best to be good listeners.

Bible Story

11:10-11:25

Welcome Song

- Welcome all the children by singing their welcome song
- (Tune of Twinkle Twinkle Little Star)
- Welcome, Welcome Everyone
- Now you're here Let's have some fun
- First let's clap our hands like so
- Then reach down and touch our toes
- Welcome, Welcome Everyone
- Now you're here Let's have some fun
  - You can call a group of children names to welcome them and they can stand up and wave if you'd like.

Use the Bible story pictures in your bin to tell the story. Each bullet point correlates to one picture and is written on the back of it.

SAY Good morning everyone! Today we are going to see how God promised to save us.

- When God made Adam and Eve, He made them to be like Him- they were good!
- God loved them and told them not to eat from one tree in the garden they lived in.
- When they didn't listen to God, he made them live in a new place and gave them new rules to follow. God was sad that Adam and Eve couldn't live in the garden with Him anymore.
- God promised that one day, people would be able to live with God again.
- After many years, some people tried to love God and some people didn't.
- God told some men to tell people how God would save them.
- Jesus was who God promised would come to save us!
- Even when Adam and Eve didn't listen to God, God still loved them and wanted to save them.
- He loves us too and wants us to trust Jesus to save us!

### Craft/Coloring Page


11:25-11:35

After the story, have the children go to their tables and prepare for a craft to go along with the lesson. Our BIG IDEA of the week is: God Promised to Save Us!

Distribute the 'God Loves Me!' page to each child. place dot markers at each table and help the children to fill in the circle.

As children finish, distribute the coloring page with today's story on the back for children to continue coloring, have the children place both the craft and coloring sheet in their bin when they are finished.

• This is the second week of focusing on this verse. Some children may already know the motions and some may not. Be sre to review them with everyone!

○ to save- make an 'X' with your arms across your chest

○ the world- make a circle with your hands

○ John 3:17- Make a 3 with your fingers

• Have the children joing you in saying the verse and doing the motions several times to practice. Ask the children if anyone would like to do the verse on their own. If someone needs help, have them pick a friend or do it with them. If no one volunteers, repeat as a class twice more.

#### Snack Time at Tables

12:05-12:15


Once the snack and read aloud are finished, the children may choose free play until their parents come to pick them up.


