Transitions At Mt. Calvary

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

Changes are coming to Mt. Calvary. We learned recently that our Office Manager, Jenn Welsh, will be departing Mt. Calvary on July 24th to take on a new opportunity to coordinate volunteers willing to spend their time with individuals and their families going through hospice. While we are sad to see Jenn go, we're grateful for her ministry at Mt. Calvary over the past 16 months. She joined us during the craziness of Holy Week 2024, survived that, and has gone on to help our congregation in many ways. One of the things I'm most thankful to Jenn for is how she has helped to modernize much of our printed and digital content as well as many of our processes for inter-church communication. We know that she will be a blessing to her new employer and especially to the clients that will be served through her ministry. We invite you to keep the entire Welsh family in prayer as they proceed in their journey of faithfulness to Jesus Christ.

For Mt. Calvary, our Staff-Parish Relations Committee is faithfully at work during this transition to discern who God is calling to fill this role. We are also discerning if it is time to make adjustments to the responsibilities of this position at the Church. During this time, we invite your patience and flexibility when it comes to coverage in the physical office itself. Know that I am always available by phone and email if you need to reach me.

We also were recently informed that our custodian, Dawn, will be retiring from her employer, Omex, on July 16th. Dawn has been a wonderful blessing to Mt. Calvary, always ready to care for whatever we asked. She will very much be missed and we are thankful for how she cared for our facilities, particularly during COVID which provided some very unique challenges.

Because we contract this service out, by the time you read this we will likely already have a new custodian in place. We invite your prayers for Dawn as she moves into retirement from Omex, particularly for her physical health. We also invite your prayers for whomever our new custodian will be as they come to serve at Mt. Calvary.

While staff changes are never easy we're excited to see what God has in store for the people of Mt. Calvary moving forward. The wonderful thing about this church is that its foundation is Christ Who will always provide all that we need in order to be effective in ministry. He never changes and that is something we can always put our hope in. At the same time, the biggest part of that provision of Christ to Mt. Calvary is YOU, the people of Mt. Calvary who volunteer, serve, give, worship, and love with everything you have. Thanks be to God for the ministry of those who have come, who have gone, and who are yet to come.


