

A Spiritually Strong Summer

IT'S SUMMER TIME!!! Summer is a season we all look forward to—warmer weather, vacations, family time, and a welcome change of pace. But as our routines shift and calendars fill up, it's easy for our spiritual practices to take a back seat. Church attendance may become more sporadic, Bible study groups pause, and our prayer lives can start to drift. That's why now is the perfect time to remind ourselves: God doesn't take a summer break—and neither should our faith.

Just as we care for our bodies with sunshine, exercise, and rest, our souls need regular nourishment. Prayer, Scripture reading, worship, and service aren't just "church activities"—they are lifelines that keep us rooted in Christ. Without them, we may find ourselves running on empty, even while our schedules are full.

Here are a few ways to stay spiritually engaged this summer:

- Take Church with You: Our Sunday services are livestreamed every week. And, if you can't catch the live, they're always available to watch later on under the "live" tab on our church youtube page.
- **Expand Your Worship Horizons:** Maybe you're traveling and watching online isn't for you. If that's the case, find a local church to visit wherever you are. Maybe you'll return with some wonderful ideas to enhance worship here at Mt. Calvary!
- Start a Summer Devotional: Choose a short daily plan—perhaps a Psalm a day or a theme like "gratitude" or "trust." It doesn't have to be long to be meaningful. If you're looking for a place with easy access, remember that the Bible App (YouVersion) has daily devotions and plans to select from as well. If you're friends with me on Facebook, you'll see I share a verse and prayer from that app every day.
- **Pray as You Go**: Whether you're walking the beach, hiking a trail, or sitting on the porch, let nature lead you into moments of prayer and reflection. Personally, I find that there is no better place to discover what we mean to God than by being out in the midst of His beautiful creation
- **Serve Together**: Use the extra daylight hours to bless someone else. Volunteer at Wonders Found. Help with VBS. Join the Youth Mission Trip. Call someone you've been meaning to. Write an encouraging note. Our faith grows through actions that make us the hands and feet of Christ.

So Church, let's not let spiritual growth take a vacation. This summer, may we find fresh ways to draw near to God, even as we enjoy all that the season offers. Our walk with Christ is too important to put on pause. Stay rooted. Stay connected. And trust that God will meet you wherever you are—at the beach, in the mountains, or right here at home.

Women's Ministries


