## MORNING MESSAGE

"Answers in Genesis" or "The Divided States of America" Genesis 1:1, 27; 2:24; 9:18

I. GENESIS ANSWERS THE ATHEISM QUESTION – "In the beginning God" (1:1a)

Psalm 19:1, "The heavens declare the glory of God"

II. GENESIS ANSWERS THE EVOLUTION QUESTION — "In the beginning God created" (1:1b)

2 Peter 1:21, "Holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost"

Nehemiah 9:6, "Thou, even thou, art Lord alone; thou hast made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein, the seas, and all that is therein, and thou preservest them all; and the host of heaven worshippeth thee"

Psalm 102:25, "Of old thou hast laid the foundation of the earth: and the heavens are the work of thy hands"

John 1:1, "All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made"

Colossians 1:16, "For by him were all things created that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him"

III. GENESIS ANSWERS THE GENDER IDENTITY QUESTION – "So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them" (1:27)

Genesis 5:2, "Male and female created he them"

Matthew 19:4, "Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female"

Mark 10:6, "But from the beginning of creation God made them male and female"

Psalm 139:14, "I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made"

IV. GENESIS ANSWERS THE GAY MARRIAGE QUESTION – "Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh" (2:24)

Ephesians 5:32, "This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church"

V. GENESIS ANSWERS THE RACISM QUESTION – "And the sons of Noah, that went forth of the ark, were Shem, and Ham, and Japheth" (9:18)

Genesis 11:9, "and from thence did the Lord scatter them abroad upon the face of the earth"
