MORNING MESSAGE "Friends, Foes, and Failures" 2 Timothy 4:9-15

- I. THE DESIRED TIMOTHY (v.9)
  - A. Paul's desire was demanding
  - B. Paul's desire was dangerous
  - C. Paul's desire was direct
- II. THE DISAPPOINTING DEMAS (v.10a)
  - A. Demas is mention three times in Scripture
    - 1. Colossians 4:14, "Luke, the beloved physician, and Demas, greet you"
    - 2. Philemon 23-24, "There salute thee Epaphras, my fellow prisoner in Christ Jesus; Marcus, Aristarchus, Demas, Lukas, my fellow laborers"
    - 3. 2 Timothy 4:10, "Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed into Thessalonica"
- III. THE DIFFICULT CRESCENS (v.10b)
- IV. THE DISCIPLER TITUS (v.10c)
  - A. Titus is one of Paul's preacher boys
    - 1. Titus 1:4, "To Titus, mine own son after the flesh"
    - 2. Titus 1:5, "For this cause left I thee in Crete, that thou shouldest set in order the things that are wanting"
- V. THE DEVOTED LUKE (v.11a)
  - A. Luke was Paul's companion
  - B. Luke was Paul's correspondent
- VI. THE DYNAMIC MARK (v.11b)
  - A. Mark's story is told in the book of Acts
    - 1. In Acts 12 he is a disciple
    - 2. In Acts 13 he is a dropout
    - 3. In Acts 15 he is a divider
  - B. Mark's failure was not final
    - 1. Colossians 4:10, "Aristarchus my fellow prisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas"

- 2. Philemon 24, "Marcus, Aristarchus, Demas, Lucas, my fellow laborers"
- 3. 1 Peter 5:13, "Marcus my son"

### VII. THE DEPENDABLE TYCHICUS (v.12)

- A. Tychicus is mentioned five times in Scripture
  - 1. In Acts 20 he was dispatched to Jerusalem
  - 2. In Ephesians 6:21 he is called a "beloved brother" and "faithful minister"
  - 3. In Colossians 4:7 Paul adds "fellow servant"
  - 4. In Titus 3:12 he is listed as a possible replacement for Titus
- B. Tychicus is mentioned in two footnotes
  - 1. Ephesians, "Written from Rome unto the Ephesians by Tychicus"
  - 2. Colossians, "Written from Rome to the Colossians by Tychicus and Onesimus"

## VIII. THE DELIGHTFUL CARPUS (v.13)

- A. This is the only time Carpus is named in Scripture
  - 1. "Cloak" describes a heavy garment
  - 2. "Books" means books written on papyrus
  - 3. "Parchments" means books written on animal skin; probably the Old Testament Scriptures

# IX. THE DEVIOUS ALEXANDER (vv.14-15)

- A. Alexander was a common name
  - 1. There are at least five men named Alexander in the Bible
    - a. Mark 15:21 one of the sons of Simon of Cyrene
    - b. Acts 4:6 a leader in Jerusalem
    - c. Acts 19:33 at the Ephesus riot
    - d. 1 Timothy 1:20 a man who Paul turned over to Satan
- B. Paul was willing to let God take care of Alexander
  - 1. Deuteronomy 32:35, "To me belongeth vengeance and recompense"
  - 2. Romans 12:19, "Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord"
