Revelation 21:1-8

 - A. Eight characteristics of people who will not be in heaven
 - 1. The fearful
 - 2. The unbelieving
 - 3. The abominable
 - 4. The murderers
 - 5. The whoremongers
 - 6. The sorcerers
 - 7. The idolaters
 - 8. The liars
 - B. Paul gave a similar list in 1 Corinthians 6:9-10, “Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, no effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God”
 - 1. None of these sins cannot be forgiven

2. Paul adds, “And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God” (1 Corinthians 6:11)
