MORNING MESSAGE

“Get Connected”

Acts 2:37-46

- I. GET CONNECTED TO GOD’S SON – “Then they that gladly received his word” (v.41a)
 - A. You must realize you are a sinner – “For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23)
 - B. You must recognize Jesus is God’s Son – “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him, should not perish, but have everlasting life” (John 3:16)
 - C. You must repent of your sin – “Except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish” (Luke 13:3,5)
 - D. You must receive Jesus as your Savior – “But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name” (John 1:12)
- II. GET CONNECTED TO GOD’S CHURCH – “Then they that gladly received his word were baptized” (v.41b)
 - A. You need to be baptized
 - 1. Biblical baptism is by immersion
 - 2. Biblical baptism is after conversion
 - 3. Biblical baptism is symbolic
 - 4. Biblical baptism is a command
 - B. You need to be faithful to the church
 - 1. Attend a Connection Group
 - 2. Attend the Worship Service
 - 3. Attend Wednesday Night
 - C. You need to find a place of service
- III. GET CONNECTED TO GOD’S WORD – “And they continued steadfastly in the apostles’ doctrine” (v.42a)
 - A. You need to read God’s Word
 - B. You need to study God’s Word
 - C. You need to memorize God’s Word
- IV. GET CONNECTED TO GOD’S MISSION – “And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved” (v.47b)
 - A. The mission is to tell people about Jesus

1. Acts 1:8, “And ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth”
- B. You need to learn how to share your faith
 - C. You need to look for opportunities to share your faith
