Title: "What Shall We Do?"

Text: Acts 2:37-41
Date: August 6, 2023

## Big Idea

Becoming a Christian is a journey from head through heart to hand. It isn't merely about *knowing* something; nor is it merely about *feeling* something; it is also about *doing* something. It either changes the life or it isn't real Christianity at all. "What does this mean?" (v. 12) must give way to "What shall we do?" (v. 37).

## **Two Steps**

### Step #1: Repent

In the biblical sense of the term, to repent is to *turn from* sin and to *turn towards* God and Christ and the gospel. You're not just turning from, you're turning towards. It's a bi-directional reality. We do an about face on the road to destruction and begin walking back towards the God who made us, the God who loves us, the God who sent his only beloved Son to die for us.

Peter calls us, in essence, to repent of our "crookedness". In the Bible there are two ways to be crooked . . .

- Crooked Way #1: Irreligion
- Crooked Way #2: Religion

## Step #2: Be Baptized

- Aspect #1: Picturesque Baptism pictures a number of gospel realities for us. It pictures: (1) our surrender; (2) our union (cf. Rom. 6:3-4; Col. 2:11-12); and (3) our cleansing (cf. Acts 22:16; 1 Pet. 3:21).
- <u>Aspect #2: Public</u> Baptism is not something that's administered in secret or privately. It's not something we do "with all heads bowed and all eyes closed." It's something we do out in the open. It's a public declaration to the watching world that you're with Jesus.

### **Four Gifts**

#### Gift #1: A New Record

God doesn't just wave his magic wand. He crushes his only beloved son. He puts your sin upon Jesus and makes him suffer the consequences, the judgement, the wrath . . . in your place. He took it so you don't have to.

## Gift #2: A New Intimacy

God clears our record so he can move towards us in relationship. He deals with the legal for the sake of the personal. He deals with our sin at the cross so he can then come and dwell in our hearts by the Spirit.

### Gift #3: A New Community

In Jesus we're given a new community. We're brought back into relationship with others in deep and meaningful ways. You're not alone.

### Gift #4: A New Ambition

When Peter says in Acts 2:39 that this promise is for those who are "far off", he cracks open the door that the Apostle Paul will later barrel through (cf. Acts 22:21; Eph. 2:13). The gospel is not just for the Jews. It's for everyone everywhere!

## **One Underlying Cause**

Our whole discussion this morning began with a concern for what we should do. That was the question of the crowd. But now fittingly, we end our time with Peter here drawing our attention, at last, not to what we can do, but to what God can do. That's the decisive piece. We don't save ourselves. He saves us. We call on the name of the Lord, but only because he's first called on us in mercy.
