Title: If Paul Came to the Bay: Learning to Reach Our City Like Paul

Reached Athens (Part 2)

Acts 17:16-34 Text:

-O- Big Idea

In some ways, modern day Silicon Valley is like the ancient city of Athens. It's a cultural center filled with some of the world's brightest minds doing some of the most significant work. And yet it's also one of the most unchurched and biblically illiterate places in the country. Therefore, as we watch Paul attempting to reach Athens, we learn what it might look like for us to reach the Bay Area.

After we've opened our schedules, and our eyes, and our hearts to the people in the culture around us, we're finally ready to open our mouths . . .

Three Opening Observations

Observation #1: Paul Went to the "Marketplace" (v. 17)

The "marketplace" (Gk. agora) was really the center of urban and public life in Greek cities. It served as the hub for all social, political, and commercial activities. And Paul goes there with the gospel. This tells us at least two things: first, he wasn't private with his faith; and, second: he knows that the biblical worldview can hold its own over and against all the philosophies of the world.

Observation #2: Paul "Reasoned" with Those Who Happened to Be There (v. 17)

In the Greek, this word translated as "reasoned" is the word dialegomai. It's related to our English word "dialogue." Our evangelism should begin with dialogue. We're not just talking and talking, but asking and listening. Only then can we bring the gospel to a person in a way that seems both intelligible and relevant to them.

Observation #3: Paul Was Brought to the "Areopagus" (v. 19)

The Areopagus here is the world-renowned supreme council of Athens. This is the upper crust of society in the ancient world.

Three Basic Steps

Step #1: Affirm

Because all men have been created in God's image and live in God's world, they will keep bumping into God's truth, both from within and from without (Rom. 1:18ff.). Our job is to find the rumblings of God in the ramblings of man. It will be, in some ways, suppressed and twisted, that is for sure. But it will be there nevertheless-something still rooted in biblical reality, something in the heart that's tethered off indelibly to the God in whose image they've been made. They can suppress it. But they can't escape it.

Step #2: Challenge

Even in their own system of thought and ways of worship there are things they must admit they don't understand. They can feel it, They're still missing something. There are inconsistencies and incongruities. Deep down they know. And this altar to an unknown god bears witness to that fact (v. 23).

Step #3: Invite

We affirm some things in their worldview, challenge the inconsistency of it, and then show how everything actually comes into a wonderful coherence inside the biblical framework-everything they were ultimately after with their idolatry is found in a full and lasting way only in Jesus.

One Bay Area Example

When you open your schedule and you open your eyes and you open your heart to take in what's happening here in the Bay Area, one of the "objects of . . . worship" (v. 23) we can identify quite easily is this idea of technology-technological innovation. Here is an idol that's really captured the soul of Silicon Valley.



Reflection Questions

• Think about the people in your life, those in your own spheres of influence. How can you do with them what Paul does here in Athens? What would it look like to open your schedule, open your eyes, open your heart, and open your mouth? God wants to use you to reach them!
