- A. God gives us position that we might **BE SOMETHING MORE FOR OTHERS**
- B. God gives us power so that we can **DO MORE FOR OTHERS**
- C. God gives us privilege that we can **GIVE MORE TO OTHERS**
- D. In leadership, we get to **EXPERIENCE MORE**, so we're able to **SHARE MORE WITH OTHERS**
- E. In leadership, God entrusts you with people <u>and expects you to properly lead them</u>, and prayerfully take them places (in life and in their journey with the Lord) that they perhaps had never even dreamed they'd get to go to!
- F. No set of <u>external safety measures</u> or safeguards could ever adequately protect against someone whose heart has truly gone bad or crooked.
