## II. BIBLICAL INSIGHTS ABOUT BUILDING ON THE ROCK 1. A life built on the rock "For I say to you, that **unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and** Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 5:20 (NKJV) "...**you Pharisees nullify the word of God because of your dead traditions.** You hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you: "'These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are only rules taught by men." Jesus called the crowd to him and said, "Listen and understand. What goes into a man's mouth does not make him 'unclean,' but what comes out of his mouth---that is what makes him 'unclean.'" The disciples came to him and asked, "Do you know that the Pharisees were offended when they heard this?" He replied, "Every plant that my heavenly Father has not planted will be pulled up by the roots. Leave them; they are blind guides. If a blind man leads a blind man, both will fall into a ditch." Matthew 15:6-14 to build your life on the Rock 2. You must "...Jesus...asked His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" And they said, "Some say John the Baptist, others say Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, **but my Father who is in heaven.**" And I tell you, you are **Peter**, and on this **rock** I will **build** my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. Matthew 16:13-18 (ESV)

Peter is translated from the Greek word "Petros" which means a small rock or stone that stands alone. The word Rock is translated from the Greek word "Petra" which means a large projecting rock that is a foundational rock. Peter or "Petros" is masculine, and Rock or "Petra" is feminine.
