<ul> <li>Preachers who cowardly refuse to Biblically call out sin, evil, and moral corruption</li> <li>Believers choosing to settle for non-challenging, saccharine, shallow preaching</li> <li>Falsely equating mere motivational speaking with sound preaching and teaching</li> <li>Falsely concluding that how a Christian lives is not all that important—just "believe"</li> <li>Falsely concluding that any type of rebuke or correction is "judging" and unacceptable</li> </ul>
