And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased. - ✓ Am I grateful for this experience?
- ✓ How can I turn this into a long-term success?
- ✓ Practically speaking, where do I go from here?
- ✓ Who else can I speak to who has "failed" in a similar manner, to gain a fresh perspective?
- ✓ Did I really "fail" or did I simply fall short of my own perceived standards of success?
- ✓ How can I now better be used by God to help others in the future?
- ✓ Did I really fail, or did God simply choose to change my "season"?
- ✓ If I have helped people along the way, have I truly "failed?"
