





We will be dying and donating Easter eggs for use during the Holy Week services the following week!


We will also enjoy popcorn and a movie after egg dying, so make sure to mark your calendars today for this great family event!

Our Response to the Earthquakes in Turkey and Syria

Our hearts are deeply grieved by the impact of the two massive earthquakes that struck Turkey and Syria in the early morning hours of Monday, February 6. The loss of human life and destruction of infrastructure is immense.

In an effort to help the plight of those that have been displaced and impacted with personal loss, we call on you to pray and as God enables you to give to the relief efforts.
