## ABIDING IN THE VINE

Like a branch is connected to a vine, following Jesus means living a life connected to him. ## FIRST STEPS OF FAITH

### BECOMING A FOLLOWER OF JESUS

Every person must decide for themselves whether to believe in Jesus and follow him as his disciple. That relationship begins with acknowledging that you are a sinner and receiving Jesus as your savior. The Bible defines this as being "born again." *John 3:3, 16; Romans 10:9-10.*

### WATER BAPTISM

Water baptism is the first step a believer takes. It is the outward symbol of an inward decision and commitment to follow Jesus Christ as Lord. Those who have repented of their sins are instructed to be baptized. *Acts 2:38-40; Mark 16:16; Acts 22:16; Romans 6:2-5.*
