 - i. Remodeling and outdoor projects at the farm

- i. Repairing the pool (used for recreation, outreach, & baptisms)
- ii. Other projects...TBD 😊
- 2. To **engage** in regularly scheduled church services and activities, including a community outreach Resurrection Egg Hunt on April 12th, Tieners (youth group), and their Easter Sunday worship experience.
- 3. To **partner** with the Webers in their daily lives & activities.
- 4. To **spiritually admonish & edify**, by our presence & God's Word, the missionaries and nationals serving at these ministry locations.

- 5. To **impact** as many nationals as we can with the gospel by making the most of every witnessing opportunity afforded to us while enroute and in Belgium.
- 6. To **absorb & assimilate** as much of Belgium's culture & customs as possible, enabling us to adopt a greater missional heart.

Not only will we have the opportunity to be a blessing to the people of Belgium by assisting them with various projects, but we will also share Christ & the hope found in Him.
