OUR HIGHEST PRIORITY: LOVE GOD

Deuteronomy 6:4-5 (ESV)

"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

Mark 12:29-30 (ESV)

29 Jesus answered, "The most important is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 30 And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.'

HOW TO GROW IN LOVE FOR GOD:

John 14:15-17 (ESV)

16 I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

1. ASK GOD TO CHANGE YOU (You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart)
2. <u>ALIGN</u> YOUR THINKING WITH GOD'S WORD (You shall love the Lord your God with all your mind)
3. ACT IN LOVE TOWARD GOD (You shall love the Lord your God with all your strength)
4. ACCEPT GOD'S LOVE FOR YOU (You shall love the Lord your God with all your soul)
