Reasons why we don't evangelize.

1. _____. Sharing your faith is about God. It's not about you. (Luke 18:1) Pray this prayer: *Lord today, help me to see things through Your eyes today. Place people in my path who need Your Gospel. Help me remember if God be for me who can be against me. Amen.* _____ is the most powerful tool in the work of evangelism.
2. I don't know what to say. _____. Maybe the introduction to the evangelism is not what you say, but it's what you do. (Matthew 5:16)
3. I don't want to damage my relationship. (John 13:34-35) One of the best ways to share and spread the Gospel of Christ is through loving one another.
4. You don't want your efforts to disappoint God. What if the person I share with doesn't receive Christ? Paul has an answer here. (1 Corinthians 3:1-9) _____.
