#### Lesson #4

Phillip Brooks famously defined preaching as “sharing truth through your personality.” As we evangelize, we should do it in-keeping with the personality traits that God has given us. Over the next few weeks, we’ll examine \_\_\_\_\_ different evangelism styles.

If you had to describe Peter in one word, what would it be? Let’s review Peter’s \_\_\_\_\_ approach. Examine: Acts 2:14-36. Peter’s approach gives a \_\_\_\_\_. Here are some things to keep in mind when using this evangelism style:

- You must be sensitive to the Spirit to know who, how, and when to engage this way. (Gal. 5:16)
- This approach takes \_\_\_\_\_. (Col. 4:6)
- If you use this style of evangelism, you may be someone whose spiritual gift is \_\_\_\_\_.
- Marry this style & spiritual gift with the Juicy Fruit of \_\_\_\_\_.

Though Paul could be direct and to the point, he more often used an \_\_\_\_\_ approach to the presentation of the Gospel. Examine: Acts 17:16-32. Paul starts with \_\_\_\_\_ and builds a case for why Jesus Christ is better. Here are some things to keep in mind when using this evangelism style:

- Someone with this witnessing style is very \_\_\_\_\_.
- This style is also apologetic. (1 Peter 3:15)
- One of the major challenges with this method is you can’t be out to show how smart you are—but you’re trying to show forth \_\_\_\_\_. (Proverbs 2:6)
