Prayer for Lost and Fallen

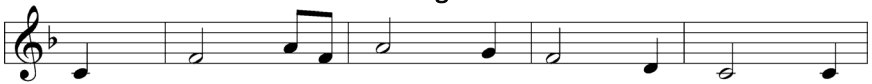
