# **Position Summary**

The Upper School Instructional Coach will support and enhance the teaching and learning process in support of PCA's mission and teaching philosophy for students in 6<sup>th</sup> through 12th grade. The primary goal of this position is to help teachers improve their instructional practices, enhance student learning outcomes, and foster a positive and effective learning environment.

Palmetto Christian Academy is seeking a full-time Upper School (grades 6-12) Instructional Coach for the 2024-25 school year. The candidate must possess at least a bachelor's degree in education with a minimum of three to five years of teaching in a middle or high school setting. The preferred candidate will possess a Master's degree in education with a concentration in Curriculum and Administration and an ACSI or South Carolina teaching certificate.

### **Primary Responsibilities**

- 1. Teacher support:
  - Conduct regular classroom observations to assess teaching practices and provide constructive feedback to teachers on instructional techniques and classroom management.
  - Collaborate with teachers to identify areas for professional growth and development.
  - Provide one-on-one coaching sessions to support teachers in implementing effective instructional strategies and be available to model lessons when needed.
  - Meet with grade level teams to provide instructional guidance and support as well as to assist in developing long-range curriculum and planning goals.
  - Mentor new teachers to ensure that they are supported and understand the expectations of the position, including instructional methods and curriculum delivery.

## 2. Administrative support:

• Provide regular updates to the Upper School principal on progress of teachers and students.

- Complete formal observations for designated Upper School teachers.
- Collaborate with the Upper School Instructional Coach to ensure vertical alignment of the instructional program and curriculum selection/implementation.

### 3. Student Support:

- Meet with teachers and parents to discuss student progress.
- Coach teachers on how to support a variety of student needs that will promote learning and growth for all students.

# 4. Curriculum support:

- Work with teachers to align curriculum with state standards and educational goals.
- Collaborate with faculty members and committees to make recommendations for curriculum updates and changes.
- Provide input on the selection of instructional materials and resources to support the curriculum.
- Assist in coordinating training opportunities for new and current curriculum and any other instructional needs.
- Support and coach teachers on how to teach their curriculum based on a biblical worldview.

#### 5. Data Analysis:

- Analyze student achievement data to identify trends and areas for improvement.
- Support teachers in using data to inform instructional decisions.
- Assist in developing and implementing strategies for data-driven instruction.
- Use achievement data to evaluate the curriculum and instruction program effectiveness.

### **Qualifications and Requirements**

- A strong testimony of a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and evidence of regular attendance and involvement in an evangelical church.
- A minimum of 3-5 years of work experience as a middle or high school teacher.
- Must possess a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in education. Preferred candidate possesses a Master's degree in Education with a concentration in Curriculum and Instruction.
- Ability to work collaboratively with classroom teachers.
- Ability to interpret data and identify performance gaps and make recommendations for improvement.
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills.
- Broad knowledge of the principles and practices of current educational trends in curriculum and instruction.
