CLASS RANK & GRADING SCALE

Palmetto Christian Academy releases rank to parents and students as requested and to scholarship committees, financial aid departments and college admissions offices as required.

GPA is calculated and weighted using the South Carolina Uniform Grading Scale (5.0), with a passing grade of 70. Honors classes are awarded an additional .5 quality point, and AP courses are awarded an additional 1.0 quality point.
