Text Truth: **Thank God and serve Him with joy.**

Bible Verse: **Serve the Lord with gladness. Come before Him with joyful songs. Psalm 100:2**

Bible Verse Paraphrase: **Serve God with gladness; sing joyful songs of praise. Psalm 100:2**

PSALM 100

The Bible has poems and songs that praise God and tell about God's goodness. The poems are called psalms. People in Bible times often chanted or sang the psalms as they went into the temple or began their worship.

One psalm is about thankfulness. The person who wrote the psalm must have loved God very much and knew that God deserves praise and glory. The person wrote:

"Let the whole earth shout to God. Sing songs of joy. Serve God with gladness."

The psalm writer said that God is good—He made us and loves and cares for us. We are His children.

The psalm reminds people to worship God with thanksgiving and praise. "Give thanks to God and bless His name, for the Lord is good. His love is forever. He will be faithful to His people forever."
