The man didn't know who Jesus was or that He healed people. The man just answered, "The man who made me well said to pick up my mat and walk."


Later, Jesus saw the healed man in the temple. "You are well now," Jesus said.


Then the man hurried to tell the synagogue leaders that it was Jesus who had made him well.
