Noah worked and worked to build the ark. Noah’s sons helped. It took a long time to build the ark. Finally, when the ark was ready, God told Noah to take his family and animals into the ark. God closed the big door.

Seven days later, the rain began to fall. It rained and rained. The rain fell for 40 days and 40 nights. It never stopped! Water was everywhere, but Noah and his family were safe in the ark.

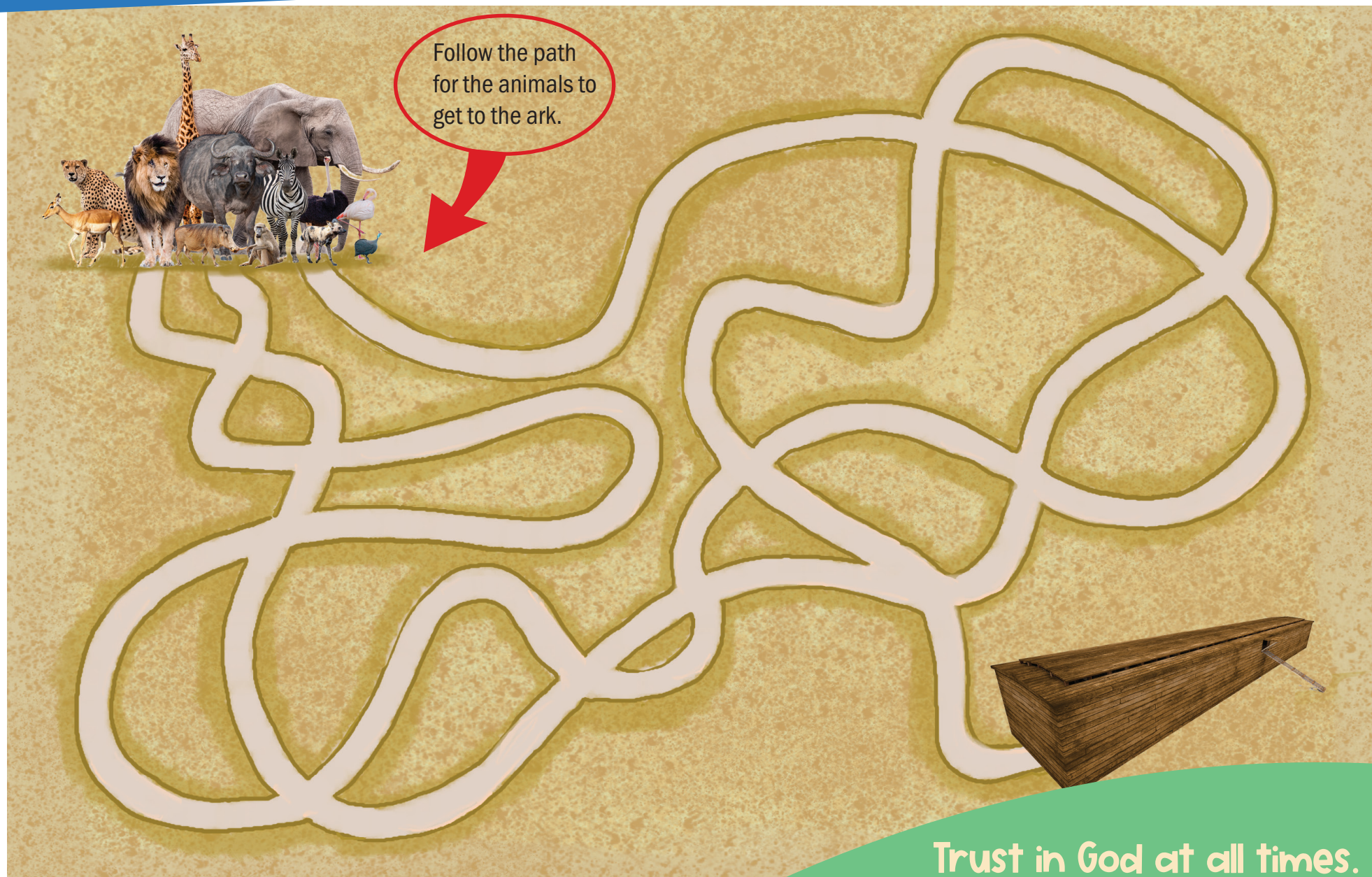
Finally, God stopped the rain. When the ground dried, God told Noah, “Come out of the ark, Noah. Bring your family out of the ark. Bring out all the animals.”
