BIBLE VERSE: I will bless you. I will make your name great. Genesis 12:2

BIBLE VERSE PARAPHRASE: I will bless you and make your name great. Genesis 12:2

God had a special plan for Abram. One night, God gave a message to Abram. “Do not be afraid, Abram. I will protect you. Your reward will be great,” God said.

Abram wondered about the reward God was talking about. Abram said, “God, what can you give me? I don’t have any children, and everything I have I will give to my servant.” God then told Abram His plan. God said Abram would have a child of his own. God told Abram to look at the sky and try to count the stars. God told Abram that his family would have children and more children until there were more people in Abram’s family than stars in the sky.
