JOHN 6:2-14

Jesus and His disciples looked for a quiet place to rest. They went up a hillside and sat down.

Jesus looked up and saw a huge crowd coming toward Him. The people wanted to see Jesus and hear more of His teaching.

Jesus turned to His disciple Philip and asked, “Where will we buy bread so these people can eat?”

This was a test for Philip. Jesus already knew what He would do.

Philip said there was no way they could provide enough bread for so many people! Then another disciple, Andrew, said, “There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish—but how good is that when there are so many people to feed?”

Jesus said, “Tell the people to sit down on the grass.”

Then Jesus took the five loaves of bread and thanked God for the food. He broke the bread into pieces for the disciples to serve to the people. Everyone had plenty of bread and fish to eat!

Jesus told His disciples to gather the food that was left over. The men picked up 12 baskets of food.

The people were amazed at what Jesus had done!
