The three programs supported by One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) — Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, the Presbyterian Hunger Program, and Self-Development of People — all work in different ways to serve individuals and communities in need. From initial disaster response, to ongoing community development, their work fits together to provide people with safety, sustenance, and hope.

The Offering provides us a way to share God's love with our neighbors in need. In fact, OGHS is the single, largest way Presbyterians come together every year to work for a better world. One Great Hour of Sharing makes a difference in the world.

<u>PRESBYTERIÁN DISASTER ASSISTANCE (PDA)</u>

Receives 32% of funds. Works alongside communities as they recover and find hope after the devastation of natural or human-caused disasters, and support for refugees In 2023, PDA granted \$6.1 million in 27 U.S. states and 46 countries.

• 131 National Response Team members were deployed to 46 presbyteries.

• 1,837 work team volunteers served in AR, CA, FL, KY, LA, MS, NC, TX and Puerto Rico, donating 127,755 hours, totaling more than \$4 million in volunteer time.

• In partnership with Church World Service, 116,273 Gift of the Heart Kits and blankets were distributed.

PRESBYTERIAN HUNGER PROGRAM (PHP)

Receives 36% of funds. Takes action to alleviate hunger, care for creation, and the systemic causes of poverty so all may be fed

In 2023, you helped PHP give 84 grants totaling \$1.1 million, impacting 19 countries and a territory, including the U.S. and Puerto Rico. PHP also partnered with

• 12 Presbytery Hunger Action Advocates, • 80 Hunger Action Congregations and • 304 Earth Care Congregations across the U.S.

<u>SELF-DEVELOPMENT OF PEOPLE (SDOP)</u>

Receives 32% of funds. Invests in communities responding to their experiences of oppression, poverty and injustice and educates Presbyterians about the impact of these issues

Projects focus on advocacy; youth-led initiatives; skills development; farming; refugee issues and capacity building. Through your gifts to One Great Hour of Sharing, projects in economically poor communities around the world have had an opportunity to develop solutions to their own challenges.
