Friends, the following is an excerpt* from a letter dated July 11 sent to BPC members that I may now share with all the friends of this amazing church that I've had the honor of serving for the last five years:

At its meeting on July 8, I informed the Session of my intention to resign as your pastor **effective August 31, 2025**. I was encouraged to apply for and have accepted a specialized pastoral call to serve the Brambleton Presbyterian Church, a 20-year-old worshipping community in Brambleton, Virginia. I realize that this may seem sudden, but when the Spirit calls, one must respond. Please do know that this decision has been made with much prayer and discernment, as I hope you will assume of me. Please also know that these last five years have been filled with the incredible blessings of being called your pastor and I leave with much love in my heart for you all.

My last Sunday in the pulpit will be August 17 when we will have a combined service at 10am, followed by a Congregational Meeting for the purpose of voting to dissolve my call with you. This is a necessary step in the process and all members are encouraged to attend. I will then hope to participate in the Blessing of the Backpacks at the park on August 24, also at 10am.

I leave truly believing that Buckingham is poised to move forward in any way the Spirit leads you. Our Session is strong - the strongest I have ever worked with in any church. Our faith-filled Deacons are committed to the service of our the church and community. Our staff is top notch; our worshipleading, youth and office needs are in good hands. And all of you – our active and committed members and friends - are simply remarkable.

Remember – the work of the church belongs to all of you – and you should be humbly proud of the work you do for the Kingdom of Heaven. I wish I could have told each of you in person, but I do hope to find time to talk and pray and say: "so long." I promise that until my last day, I will remain fully committed as your pastor. My door remains open, and I will be present with you in work and worship. Also, please be assured that New Castle Presbytery will assist you in this time of transition, recommending temporary pastoral leadership to come alongside you until calling your next pastor. This process may take some time, but I encourage all to trust the process – but more so – to trust that God is in the process.

Friends, please know that I give thanks for each of you and have faith and confidence that Buckingham Presbyterian Church will continue to grow and thrive. I wish you every blessing shared in the peace and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. In my first sermon back in 2020, I encouraged us to say: "Let's Go, Buckingham, let's go!" And we have come a long way together, in both new and tried-and-true missions and ministries which bless God, our community and our families and youth. May I encourage you now to say: "Let's keep going, Buckingham, trusting the Holy Spirit to lead the way!"






FLATJESUS WHERE HAS HE BEEN?
