Dear BPC Friends - The season of Lent is upon us! Beginning on **Ash Wednesday, March 5**, and for the next several weeks to follow, we will be taking a journey together through the season of Lent as it leads us to Holy Week. Lent, when taken seriously, can be both a spiritually challenging time as well as a spiritually cleansing time as we prepare our hearts to again remember and celebrate the events of Jesus's passion and His subsequent resurrection.

Throughout Lent this year, we will be guided by one particular scripture that we all know and love: **Psalm 23**. Week by week, verse by verse, we will go deeply into this ancient prayer of trust and guidance for our Lenten walk. Together, we will learn to be guided by the Shepherd more closely - whether it's through green pastures, or beside still waters, or to abundant banquet tables, and even through the darkest valleys of life. In the end, we will proclaim once again our lives lived in the light of Jesus's resurrection, and the new life offered to all in Him.

We will take this journey both in Sunday services, as well as in our Thursday night Bible studies. No workbooks required - just a Bible and your prayerful thoughts on what it means to follow and give your life in trust to the Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ. I hope you will join us for services, studies, and various times of fellowship throughout the season. Then, of course, we will celebrate Holy Week starting with Palm Sunday on April 13 with a combined service at 10 AM; special Holy Week services for Maunday Thursday (with a pot luck of our favorite Spring-time foods) on April 17 at 6 o'clock in Taylor Hall, a quiet reflective Good Friday service on April 18 at 6 o'clock in the chapel, and then of course Easter Sunday morning with services at 9 and 11 with our Easter egg hunt in-between services.

I so look forward to this special time in our faith lives together. Remember, Lent means "spring" - so let's enjoy the change of seasons both in the church and in the world around. Let's do so with prayers for the world: prayers for peace, prayers for compassion, prayers for empathy and prayers for Resurrection light and love to be shared and felt and lived by all.
















from the DEAGONS

\$30 per person includes fabric, prep work and sewing machines. Class size is limited and for ages 8 and up.



Per Capita: Did you notice that the very first envelope in the offering boxes is a different size and color from the others? This envelope is for EACH confirmed member of the Presbyterian Church (USA) to donate a designated dollar amount as a yearly, voluntary contribution.

This year, the Per Capita amount for 2025 is \$30 per member of which \$10.84 will go toward PC (USA); \$1.15 toward the Synod of the Mid-Atlantic; and the remaining \$18.01 toward New Castle Presbytery to fund the shared governing and mission of the greater PC USA church. Buckingham Presbyterian Church is required to pay the designated Per Capita amount for each member we have on the rolls. By contributing your portion in the envelope provided, you will help free up dollars in our regular budget for the work of our congregation in the greater Berlin community.
