Please choose one of the following written assignment OPTIONS, which must be turned in to your Language Arts teacher by the **first full day of school**.

Option#1-

Write a diary, as the main character, explaining the main events of the story. It must include at least four entries reflecting the events from the beginning, middle, and end of the book. This should be at least two handwritten pages in length, skipping spaces between lines. If you are typing your paper, it should be at least 1 ½ pages, double spaced.

-OR-

Option #2-

Write a letter to a friend about the book you read. Explain why you liked or did not like the book. Include the plot, summary, main characters, and three specific examples from the story to support your recommendation (250-300 word count typed and double spaced.)
