Week #2 - Why We're Asking You to Go All In



### GETTING STARTED

When you were a kid, what's something you remember saving up money for — and how did it feel once you finally had enough to buy it?

### THIS WEEK'S THEME

The sermon said, "You are surrounded by exceedingly generous people." When have you seen generosity on display at Calvary or in your own life?

What part of the message about generosity or open-handed living challenged or encouraged you the most?

Read 1 Chronicles 29:1-17

What do you notice about King David's attitude toward wealth and power? How is it different from how most people view success today?

Read verse 14 again. Why is David's statement — "Everything comes from you" — such a powerful truth for shaping how we give?

How does this story remind you of something Jesus taught about generosity or stewardship?

The sermon mentioned that generosity is about letting your money follow Jesus. What might that look like practically in your life?

Why do you think gratitude and humility are key to generosity?

How could our group or church together go "All In" to make a difference in our community?

### TAKING IT HOME

*Consider one intentional act of generosity this week — big or small — that stretches your trust in God.*
