SESSION 1 – Luke 1

God Speaks Up, Shows Up & Keeps Promises

1. When have you faced uncertainty, and how can you remind yourself that God's promises are still in motion – even if you can't see it yet?
2. During those moments in your life where the future isn't clear, how do you trust God's never-failing promises?

SESSION 2 – Luke 2:1-20

Good News in the Mess

1. Why do you think God chose to reveal the birth of Jesus first to lowly shepherds and what does that say about the nature of God's grace?
2. When have you experienced unexpected grace in your own life, and how does that shape the way you view others who might feel unworthy or overlooked?

SESSION 3 – Luke 2:21-3:20

Preparing the Way

1. How does God's grace challenge your view of who's "in" or "out" of God's story?
2. Who in your life might feel like an outsider and how might you reflect God's radical inclusion to them this week?

SESSION 4 – Luke 3:21-4:13

Into the Wilderness

1. How does knowing God's love is spoken over us change how we view God, ourselves and others?
2. What does Jesus' facing temptation as "one of us" mean to you, and how does it shape the way you extend grace to people who are struggling or feel excluded?

SESSION 5 – Luke 4:14-44

Hurling Jesus Off a Cliff

1. What does Jesus being rejected by those who thought they knew Him best reveal about how we sometimes resist grace when it doesn't fit our expectations?
2. How can you be more intentional about welcoming and including those who are different from you in your faith journey?

SESSION 6 – Luke 5:1-11

What does Jesus call us into?

1. When have you disqualified yourself from a call from God?
2. How can God use your past to help others?

SESSION 7 – Luke 5:17-26

Roof Breakers

1. Who are the roof breakers, or bus movers in your life?
2. How can you live a more communal faith today? Who could you reach out to and help?

SESSION 8 – Luke 11:1-13

Can I Get Your Number?

1. When is a time you felt open to prayer in your life?
2. What's a time you found the symbolism of the Lord's prayer really important?

SESSION 9 - Luke 10:25-37

Dangerous Unselfishness

1. How can we live with "Dangerous Unselfishness"?
2. In the context of the story of the Good Samaritan, what kind of person is the least likely you would want to stop and help?

SESSION 10 – Luke 15:11-32

Whose Story is It?

1. Do you trust your story for your life?
2. Or do you trust God's story?

SESSION 11 – Luke 16:19-31

Who's At Your Gate?

1. Who's at your gate? Is there someone God's been prompting you to see, to learn from, or to serve?
2. What does it look like to live open-handed—to use your resources for others, not just yourself?



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SESSION 12 – Luke 10:1-24; Luke 14

What Does Discipleship Look Like?

1. Where is Jesus asking you to “go” or to trust him, even when the path feels uncertain or uncomfortable?
2. What might Jesus be calling you to give up—or to re-evaluate—in order to follow him more fully?

SESSION 13 – Luke 19:28-44

The King We Didn’t Expect

1. How does your understanding of power (or the world’s understanding) align or not align with Jesus?
2. What changes when we see Jesus as the humble King who came to transform our hearts – not just improve our circumstances?

SESSION 14 – Luke 22:14 - 23:56

Love That Doesn’t Hold Back

1. What part of Jesus’ journey to the cross stands out to you the most—and why?
2. Where in your life might you trust God more fully, even when it's hard?

SESSION 15 – Luke 24

Resurrection Changes Everything

1. Where in your life have you felt like the story was over—and how does the resurrection speak into that?
2. Jesus met His followers in their fear, confusion, and doubt. Where might Jesus be meeting you right now?
