



## **Position: Interim EPIC (9th-12th grade) Coordinator**

**Purpose:** *High School Students are asking questions like: Where do I belong? Why should I believe? How can I matter? Calvary's goal is to create spaces where students can form authentic relationships with themselves, peers, and mentors, to have a sense of community and belonging, and to be able to ask freely the big questions of faith.*

*The EPIC Interim Coordinator will work closely with the Executive Pastor to implement a strong program of education, ministry and service opportunities for Calvary's high school students and their families through the programmatic year of 2026-2027.*

## **Calvary Next Gen Goal: To own a generous and authentic faith**

- Mentored by caring, authentic adults
- Experienced in community, not isolation
- Practiced and active, worship, connect, serve, give
- Have a growing understanding of the Biblical narrative and the Way of Jesus

## **Hours: approximately 5-10 hours per week**

Wednesday evenings from 6:15 - 9:30, various team meetings, planning and preparation time

## **Key Job Duties & Responsibilities:**

1. Responsible for oversight of ministry to Calvary's 9th-12th grade engagement, including Wednesday night programming
2. Recruitment and Equipping of Small Group Leaders for each Wednesday night
3. Create safe ministry environments, including two deep leadership, background checks, and safety of ministry space
4. Work with communications team to communicate effectively with High Schoolers and their families
5. Participation in Confirmation (October) and High School Senior Recognition (May)
6. Create welcoming and accepting environments

## **Working Conditions:**

- Schedule will include night and weekend work
- Moderate lifting required (up to 40 pounds)
