Christ has entrusted all of us with the care of His bride as He uses each of us to reach our community and the nations with the Gospel.

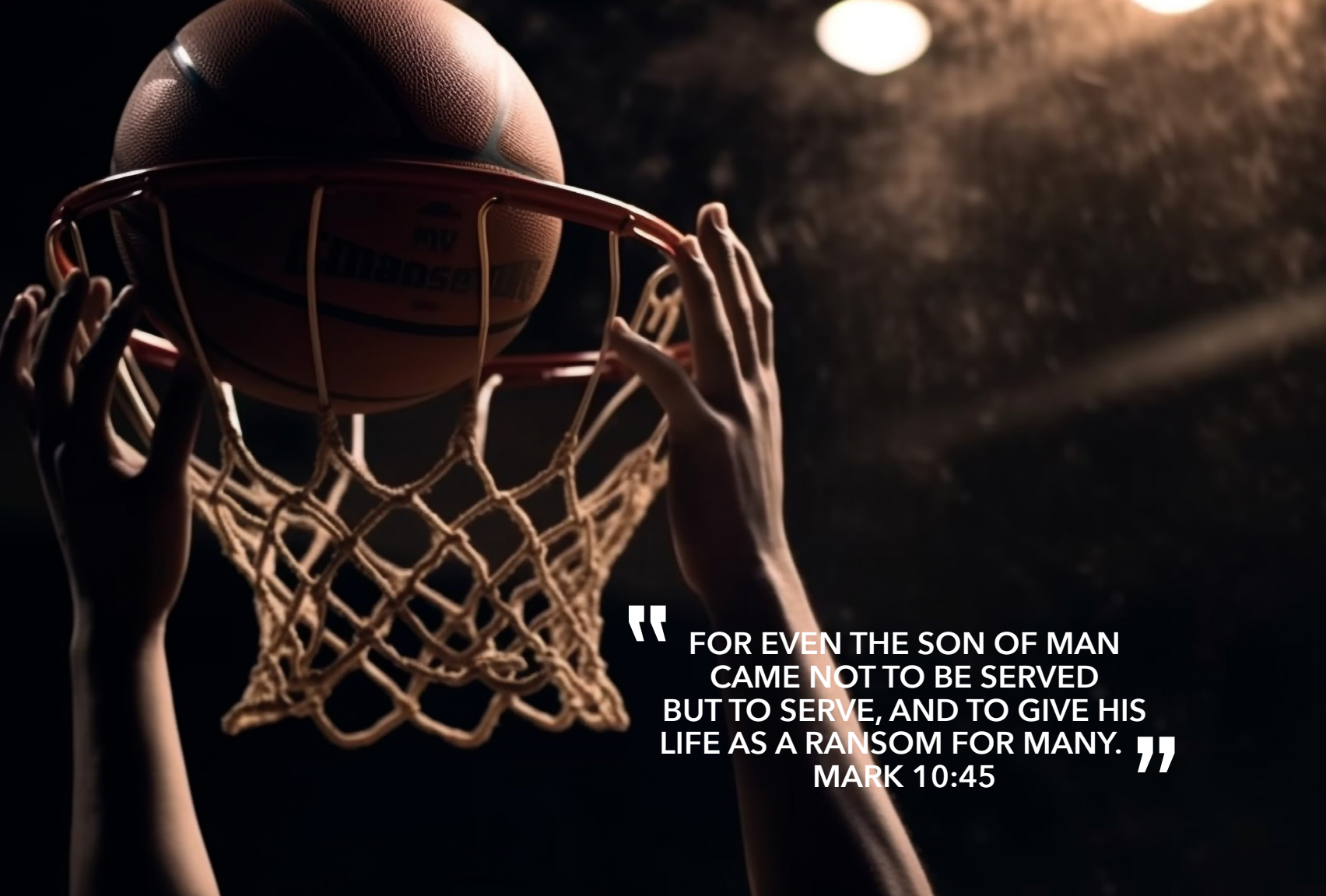

HOSPITALITY TEAM

The Hospitality Team at FBCF exists to facilitate an excellent worship environment before, during, and after the Sunday worship services for all members and guests.

Help guests get connected to Wednesday evening activities.

Assist families checking in children for Preschool, Children's and First Friends. The Check-In Team will also assist the Welcome Team in registering first time guests and showing them to their appropriate small group rooms.

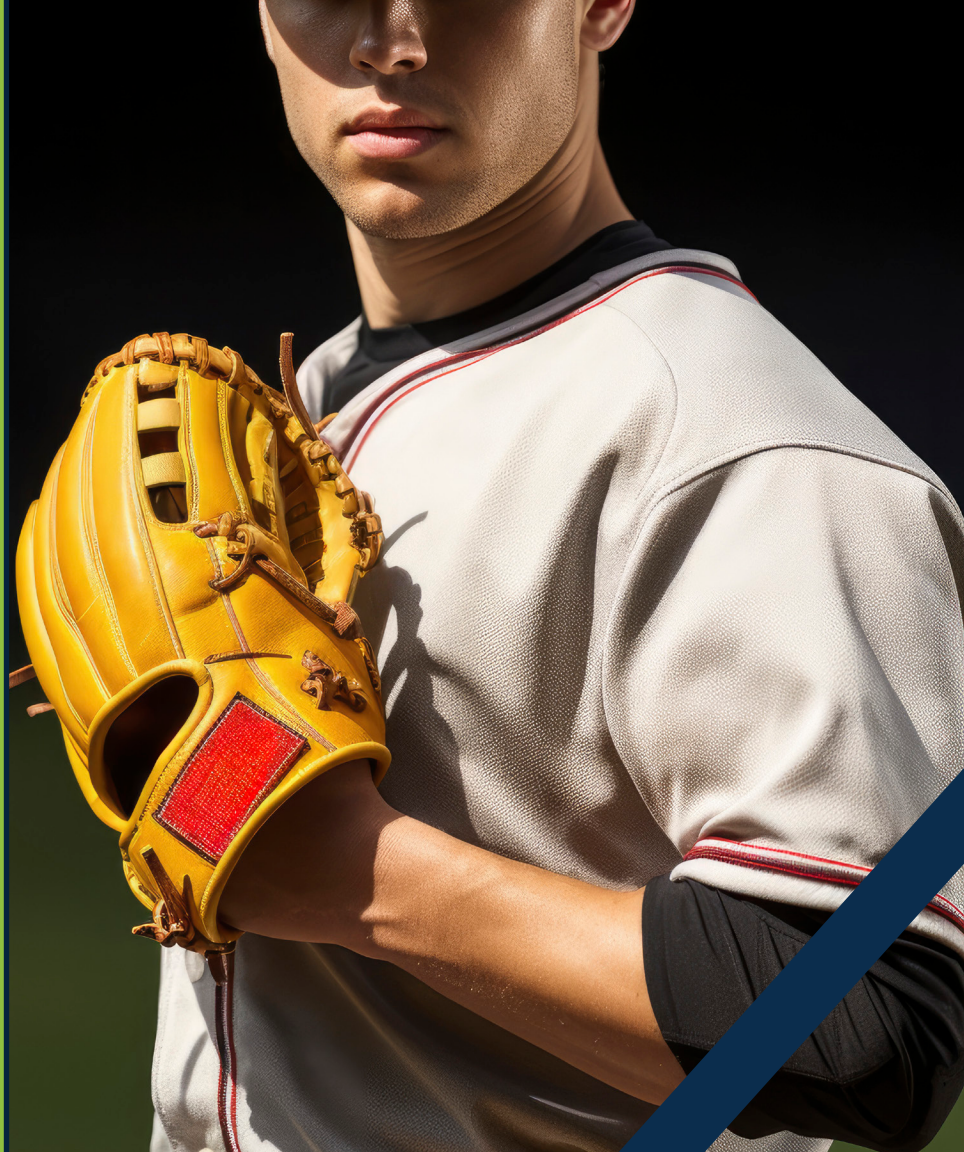

Our Sunday LifeGroup leaders serve with us on a weekly basis in a minimum of 3 person teams. They rotate teaching our Bible study lesson, care for students in the group through prayer and follow up, and look to build meaningful relationships with their students. Our groups are divided by grade and gender at both hours with two exceptions. We will have one Middle school LifeGroup at 9:15 am and one high school LifeGroup 10th-12th at 11:00 am so that we have a place for any student at both hours of LifeGroups. We provide curriculum and will coach you in effectively caring for your group of students.

Our Wednesday night service for 7th-12th grade students is called The House. The House is a “front door” to our student ministry. We worship, preach sermons geared toward teens, and aim to build meaningful community.

We need leaders to build relationships with students, model behavior and serve as an example for how to worship King Jesus in a group setting, and serve as small group coaches for our student leaders who serve as small group discussion leaders.

Typical Wednesday nights include hang out time from 6:00-6:30 pm; service from 6:30-7:30 pm, and small groups from 7:30-8:00 pm. Every other week we also have post-service activities like House Parties and WAC (Wednesday After Church) where we need adult help from 8:00-9:00 pm.
