Budget 2024

Overview

The 2024 budget reflects a continuation and further refinement of the strategy initiated by Bishop Lee and the Executive Council following his becoming our Provisional Bishop of Milwaukee in April 2021.

The overarching theme of the budget is maximizing the channeling of resources to mission through direct support of parishes, growing formation programs for youth and optimizing the utilization of funds flow from restricted investments to the programs they are intended to assist.

The important points to note about the budget are :

- Assessment rates have not changed
- Total revenue and expenses have increased by \$218k to \$2.25m
- Direct Mission expenditure has increased to 70% of the budget
- The Diocesan staff is ready and able to assist you with research, program development, finance and accounting, budgetary and administration matters and any other facets of our common Christian life that will help parishes, the diocese and our communities to grow. Sources Funding for Diocesan Budget

Funding for the Diocesan comes from the following sources:

- Cash distributions from Endowment or invested funds
- Bequests or donations received
- Assessment upon parishes for the common mission of the Diocese. The current assessment
 model has been in place for more than a decade and is similar to the model of most medium to
 large Dioceses and expects that parishes with larger operating revenue streams are able to
 contribute more to the benefit of the entire Diocese than those with smaller revenues. Note that
 the assessment rate above \$300k does not increase and that the historic rate applied at this
 point reflects the average effective rate applied up to this point.

Types of Endowment Funds or Invested Funds

Funds that are invested via the Trustee of Funds and Endowments fall into the following categories:

- Restricted Funds There are rules governing how income from the investment capital may be used.
- Unrestricted Funds Income from the invested capital is for support of the Diocesan budget.

In both cases, the funds may or may not be 'distributing' funds. Funds that are distributing funds will have distributions at the prevailing rate set by the Trustee of Funds and Endowments. At the moment this is 4.91% of the average five-year rolling value of the funds.

Not all funds are distributing. Some funds have yet to meet the criteria set by donors to distribute. This could be a time-based rule or a requirement that a certain value must be reached before income distributions are allowed.

Distributions of Restricted Funds held for the benefit of the diocese flow to specific diocesan programs. Examples include:

- Campus Ministry
- Christian formation programs including youth ministry
- Seminarian financial support
- Church camp scholarships
- Strategic parish development programs
- Outreach programs

In addition to funds managed by the Trustee of Funds and Endowments, the Diocese is the beneficiary of two trusts that distribute income annually. These funds are not controlled by the Diocese but the Diocese is the sole perpetual beneficiary.

Some funds were created by resolution of the Executive Council for restricted purposes. Where this is the case, the restrictions may be amended by Executive Council. Some of the Diocesan funds invested have been derived from past property or property-development transactions from many years ago

Mission Programs Expenditure V Diocesan Operations (General & Administrative Expenses)

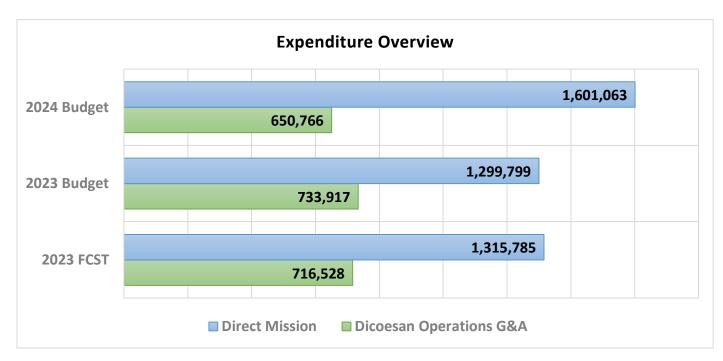
The 2024 budget shows \$0.3m more in expenditure on mission programs versus the 2023 budget. The 2024 budget shows \$83k less in total diocesan operations G&A expenses versus 2023.

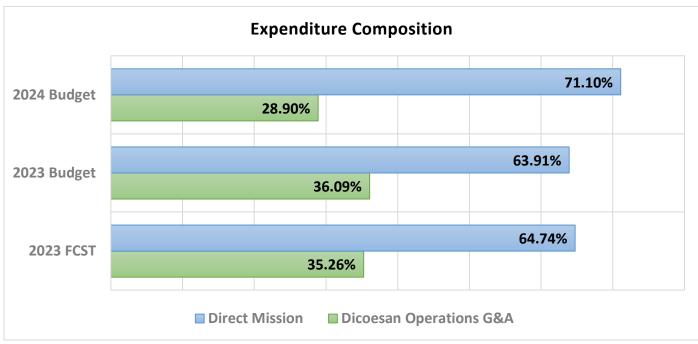
In 2024 Direct Mission focused expenditure is 70% of the budget versus 63.5% in 2023. Direct Mission expenditure is all of the outward focused funding from the Diocese that flows through to mission & ministry operations.

We include in mission programs the funds we annually remit to the Episcopal Church to support its programs. The 2024 budget includes an increased assessment on the Diocese based on 2022 operating revenue and also a budget of \$50k for 2024 general convention attendance by diocesan deputies.

Diocesan Operations or General and Administrative "G&A" expenditure is the cost of running the Diocesan entity (mostly in the background) to administer the function of the Diocese both internally and externally in order to facilitate both mission and ministry but also to and meet diocesan compliance obligations to the Episcopal Church and secular regulatory authorities. For the 2024 budget these expenses are 29% of the budget versus 36% in 2023. G&A includes support staff (Finance, Accounting, Legal, Regulatory &Compliance, Administration, Communications, Office infrastructure)

The 2024 budgeted G&A includes one-off expenses associated with the potential reunification of the Dioceses of Wisconsin including legal fees and communications.

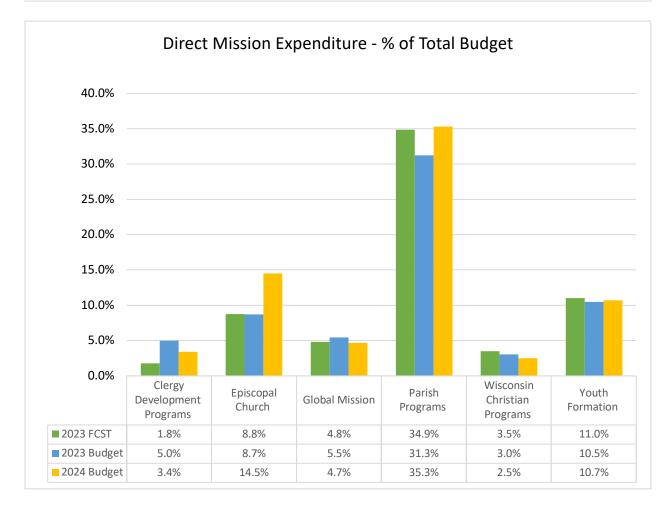




Direct Mission Expenditure is shown in the chart below and includes major components of:

- Parish Programs 35.3% of the total budget
- Youth & Campus Ministry 10.9% of the total budget
- Global Mission 4.7% of the total budget
- Episcopal Church USA 14.5% of the total budget (includes General Convention expenses)
- We increase the budget for Creation Care and the long neglected Diocesan Archives function. Creation Care is a ministry of the Episcopal Church and has a strategy to assist parishes with energy audits that help identify cost savings on utility expenses.





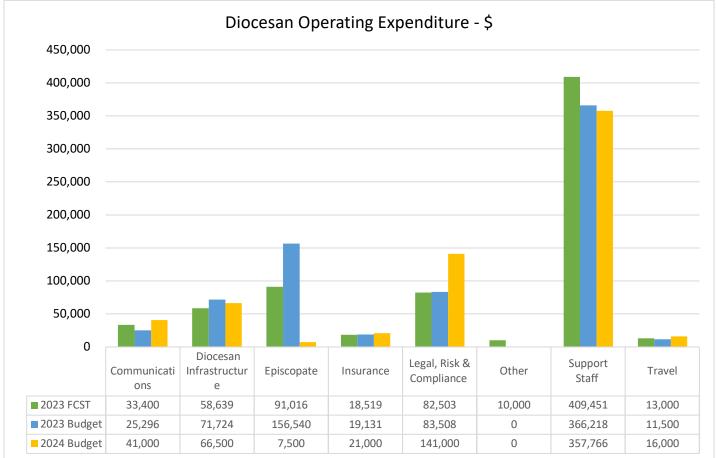
Diocesan Operations (G&A)

G&A expenses in 2024 are budgeted to decrease even after including some of the one-off expenses expected as part of the continuing Trialogue process.

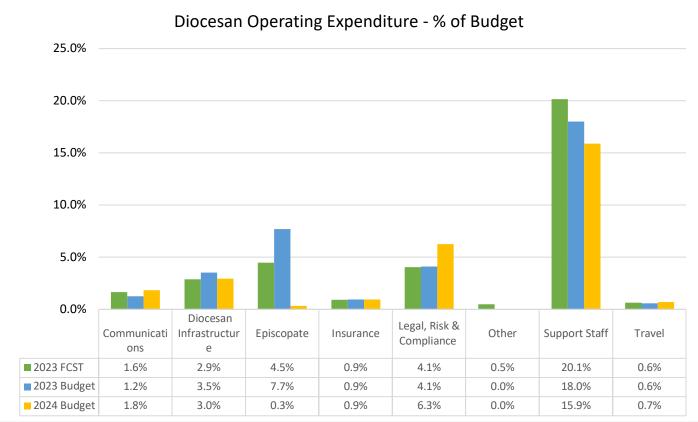
Cost savings in 2024 also include the fact that our assisting Bishop will have a very limited scope of activities until we clarify the Trialogue outcome.

Support staff expenses relative to the 2023 budget decrease from 18% to 15.9%. Some provision has been made for the relocation of the Diocesan Office from Nicholson House to a decentralized location/s. We already have plans in motion to complete this relocation and achieve a reduction in operating expenses and expect the normalized 2025 expense to be less than 2024 which is a year of transitions.

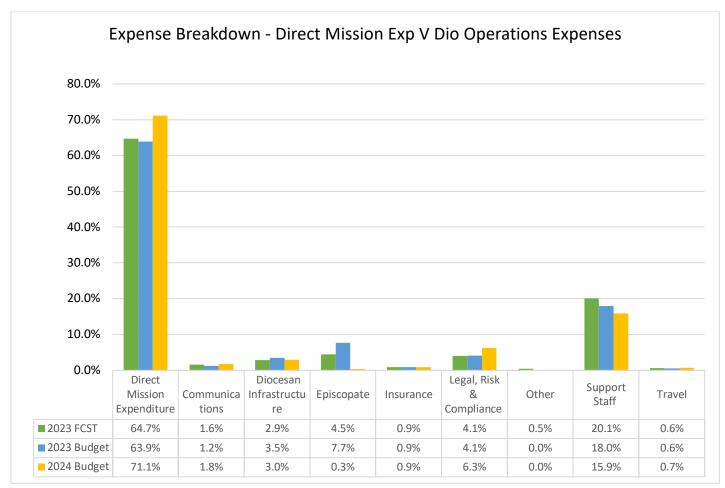
Legal expenses are budgeted higher in 2024 due to the Trialogue process should this reunification proceed.

Youth Formation

Youth Formation total of \$241k does not include grants to parishes included in the 'Parish Programs' category. It includes only campus ministry activities in Milwaukee, Whitewater and Platteville with a budget of \$138,500 and the cost of our joint venture to fund the Youth Networking Coordinator / Church Camp program we share with the Diocese of Fond Du Lac at a cost of \$102,500. This includes provision for church camp scholarships based on financial need.

Global Mission

Global Mission includes Diocesan support of the Haiti Partnership Agriculture & Economic Sustainability program. This is a separate Diocese funded program aimed at assisting the people of the St Marc's Episcopal parish in Jeanette, Haiti to achieve economic independence to allow them to ultimately become autonomous and less reliant on the donations from US philanthropic individuals and organizations towards the running of their school and medical clinic. The 2024 budget includes the costs associated with the Cassava agricultural program started in 2023 and the expense to the Diocese of managing this from afar in a different country, culture and communications in Haitian Creole. It is also a change management program that will take many years of dedication to achieve the desired results for the people of Jeanette.

Global mission also includes a \$10k budget assisting the Sisters of Mary in the Diocese of Newala and in 2023 the funds were expended on their school building program.

Global mission also includes the Commission for Global Reconciliation grants budget. In 2023 grants were awarded within two Tanzanian Dioceses, Lweru of Newala and also to the Haiti partnership Cassava agriculture program.

Clergy Development Programs

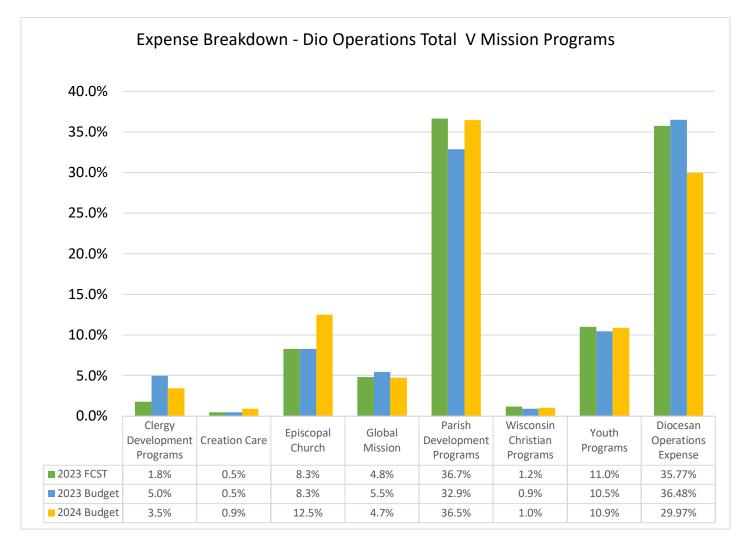
These programs include seminarian programs, Deacons programs and Clergy conference.

Wisconsin Christian Programs

Within this category are our support of Hospitality Center Racine, the Wisconsin Council of Churches, Ecumenical and Interfaith sponsorships and anticipated use of discretionary funds for the poor and underserved in our community.

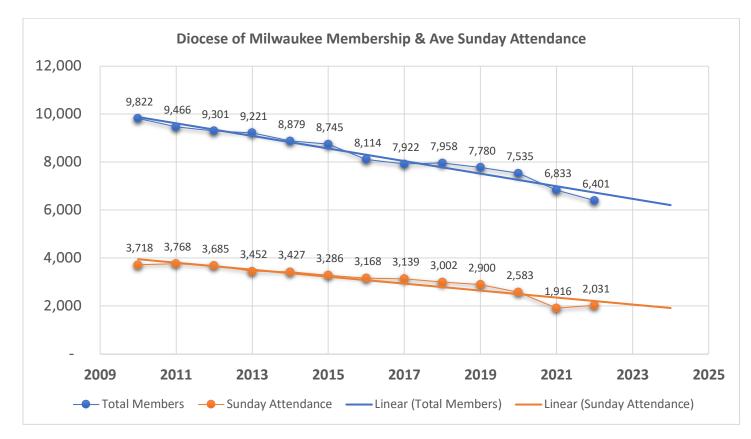
Expense Relativities

The chart below shows a breakdown of the various mission program expenditure categories versus total diocesan operations expenditure:



We know that this is an inflection point for the Episcopal Church and mainstream Christian denominations. The pandemic clarified trends that have been evident for some time. The chart below

shows the impact on membership and attendance recorded via parochial reports over the last 12 years:

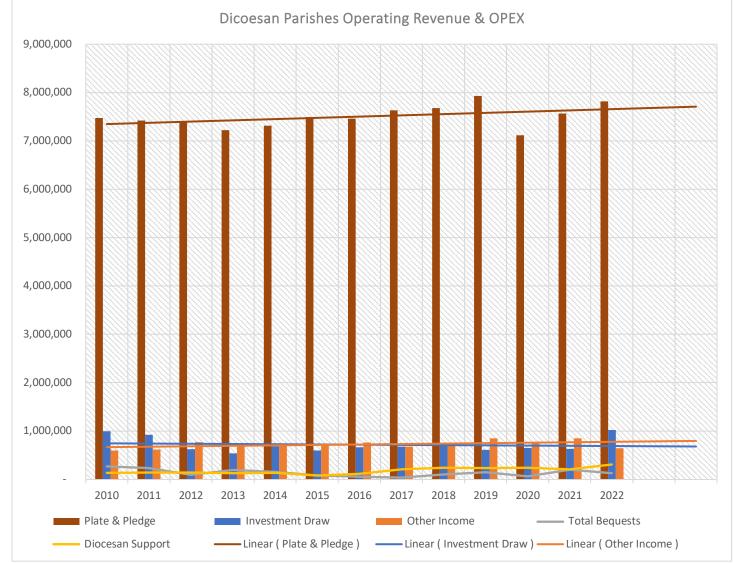


An analysis of parochial report data over the last 12 years shows that we need targeted strategies as a Diocese to optimize resources to assist our larger parishes to grow and our smaller parishes to survive. Collaboration and sharing is the key to our success. 2023 saw the implementation of collaborative models in the Diocese including:

- St Paul's Beloit & Trinity Janesville
- Platteville / Mineral Point & Campus Ministry
- Milwaukee area parishes Youth Ministry collaboration
- DioMil & DioFDL Youth Ministry
- Sussex / Menomonee Falls collaboration
- Waukesha Ecumenical collaboration
- Campus Ministry ECLA collaboration at UW Whitewater

Despite a decrease in members there has been a gradual increase in plate and pledge contributions from members. The age breakdown of Diocese of Milwaukee parishes, overall is:

0-12 years	8.83%
13-17 years	4.61%
18-34 years	8.66%
35-64 years	31.57%
>65 Years	46.33%



In Closing

- with 46% of members aged over 65 our parishes need an intentional pledge replacement endowment plan. Many of our parishes do not currently have sufficient levels of endowed funds.
- we will enlist the services of the Episcopal Church Foundation to assist parishes with a review of their assets and resources if they are willing to work with us.
- we will facilitate and encourage inter parish, community program collaboration and ecumenical collaboration.
- > we will support the growth potential of active youth ministry programs.
- > We will support growth potential in parish programs throughout the Diocese.
- We need to connect our parishes with people who are looking for an enlightened Christian spiritual path that their legacy denomination is not providing them (communications and awareness campaigns)
- We need to encourage all parishes to use Diocesan staff and resources. The Diocese and its staff are a resource for all parishes. The Diocesan staff are here to assist clergy and lay leaders with any issues that might arise and to provide support, advice, research and hands on assistance. Please use us. That is our mission.
