Singing Salvation Judges 4-5 2-5-23

I. JUDGES 4 – The Facts

1. External motivation.

Judges 4:1 - "And the people of Israel again did what was evil in the sight of the LORD after Ehud died."

- 2. God brings <u>salvation</u>.
- 3. Deborah was a woman.

II. JUDGES 5 – The Spiritual Analysis

1. Written as a song.

Judges 5:1 - "Then sang Deborah and Barak the son of Abinoam on that day..."

~ Commended the works of God to the next generation.

2. God is provident.

Judges 5:20-21 - "From heaven the stars fought, from their courses they fought against Sisera. The torrent Kishon swept them away, the ancient torrent, the torrent Kishon. March on, my soul, with might!"

3. God curses the bystanders.

Judges 5:23 - "Curse Meroz, says the angel of the LORD, curse its inhabitants thoroughly, because they did not come to the help of the LORD, to the help of the LORD against the mighty."

4. God blesses the obedient.

Judges 5:24 - "Most blessed of women be Jael, the wife of Heber the Kenite, of tent-dwelling women most blessed."

God is <u>just</u>.

Judges 5:31 - "So may all your enemies perish, O LORD! But your friends be like the sun as he rises in his might."

Romans 8:5-8 — "Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace. The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. Those who are in the realm of the flesh cannot please God."
