1 Timothy 2:8-10 – "I desire then that in every place the men should pray, lifting holy hands without anger or quarreling; 9 likewise also that women should adorn themselves in respectable apparel, with modesty and self-control, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly attire, 10 but with what is proper for women who profess godliness—with good works."

I. DISTRACTIONS TO OUR PRAYERS

- 1. #1 Distraction = Stolen Glory
 - ~ Men seeking glory through arguments.
 - ~ Women seeking glory through their appearance.
- 2. We lose when we compete with God!

1 Timothy 2:11-15 – "Let a woman learn quietly with all submissiveness. ¹² I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet. ¹³ For Adam was formed first, then Eve; ¹⁴ and Adam was not deceived, but the woman was deceived and became a transgressor. ¹⁵ Yet she will be saved through childbearing—if they continue in faith and love and holiness, with self-control."
