Francois Couperin (1668-1733) came from a very prominent musical family in France and is known as Couperin le Grand ("the Great") to distinguish him from his father Charles, uncle Louis, and others who came after them. At a very young age, Francois inherited the position of organist at the Church of Saint-Gervais in Paris from his father - a position he held until his death. He composed widely for the harpsichord and also the organ - including these settings for the mass.
