
Music Notes

Andre Raison (c. 1640-1719) was a French Baroque organist and composer of two collections of organ works including the prelude for today's service. Alexandre Guilmant (1837-1911) was organist at *La Trinite* in Paris, founded the *Schola Cantorum* where he taught organ, and also performed widely across Europe, Canada, and the United States. Gilles Jullien (c. 1651 - 1703) became organist at Chartres Cathedral as a very young person and served there until he died. All of his surviving music - about 80 pieces including today's postlude - is contained in his *Premier Livre d'orgue* (1690).
