#### Music notes

For the next several weeks we will share service music from England in the 18th and 19th centuries. James Marsh (1752-1828) was a lawyer by training who occasionally played the organ at the cathedral in Chichester. He composed a number of symphonies and over 350 pieces for the organ including today's prelude. Charles Avison (1709-1770) was organist at the cathedral in Newcastle who taught music including harpsichord, flute, and violin. He composed a number of concertos and sonatas but only a few voluntaries for organ like today's postlude.


