
The Ascension of Our Lord June 1, 2025



Pastor's Corner for June 1-7, 2025

What the Father Has Done (Ephesians 1:15-23)

This weekend we celebrate the ascension of our loving Savior Jesus. The same Jesus who was put to death on a cross and risen from the dead — appearing to His disciples bearing the wounds of His cross — is now ascended into heaven and seated at the right hand of the Father. He has experienced suffering and death, suffered hell in our place, but now sits at the right hand of the Father, with all power and with all authority. As a recent "Lutheran Hour" devotion I saw earlier this week puts it, Jesus is our "friend in high places"!

But what I love about our Epistle text on this Ascension weekend is that St. Paul gives us another way to marvel at the mystery of Jesus crucified, risen, and ascended. Paul underlines the power of the FATHER in seating the Son at His right hand.

Read Ephesians 1:18-23 ahead of worship this weekend and take a little time

considering what Jesus' ascension reveals about our Heavenly Father's authority and power. Then consider also these words from Ephesians 2: "But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, 5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions — it is by grace you have been saved. 6 And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, 7 in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus." What the Scriptures have to say about God the Father's power and authority in raising Jesus from death and seating Jesus at His right hand says a lot about His power and authority in our lives, too.

Did you know you were risen with Christ and seated with Him, by the Father? Did you know that by the love of God you belong to His church and are therefore a part of Jesus' body... living and risen with Him (1:23)? If you're like me, you knew that already... you just tend to forget it. Let's hang on tight to that truth together and celebrate it once again this year!


