"The Golden Calf and the God of Mercy"

Exodus 32:1-14

Memory Verse: 1 Timothy 2:5

Big Idea: Idolatry arises when people forget the goodness of God, provoking God's wrath which can only be satisfied by God's mediator.

- I. God Must Be Worshiped the Way He Desires to Be Worshiped (32:1-6)
 - A. God has revealed himself and his expectations to his people. God made them to be his people and entered into covenant with them.
 - B. "All the words that the LORD has spoken we will do" (Exodus 24:3).
 - C. How could this happen? They forgot the goodness of God.
 - D. They forgot the goodness of God's provision, leadership, salvation, and law.
 - E. Psalm 106:19-23
 - F. Set your mind's attention and heart's affection on the one true God and praise him for who he is and what he has done in Jesus Christ.
- II. God Knows and Is Provoked by Idolatry (32:7-10)
 - A. An idol is anything we substitute for God.
 - B. An idol is anything you love or fear more than you love or fear God.
 - C. Idolatry provokes the wrath of God.
 - D. "The wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23).
 - E. "But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed " (Romans 2:5).
 - F. Don't be stiff-necked.
- III. God Shows Compassion to His People because of His Chosen Mediator (32:11-14)
 - A. "The Glory of Israel will not lie or have regret, for he is not a man, that he should have regret" (1 Samuel 15:29).
 - B. "God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?" (Numbers 23:19).
 - C. Moses pleads for God to have mercy on his sinful people.
 - D. Moses appealed to God's fatherly affection (34:11).
 - E. Moses appealed to God's public reputation (34:12).
 - F. Moses appealed to God's everlasting covenant (34:13).
 - G. "The Hebrew verb (naham) does not always mean to change one's mind, but can also mean to be moved to pity/to have compassion for others" (John Currid).
 - H. God had mercy on his people.
