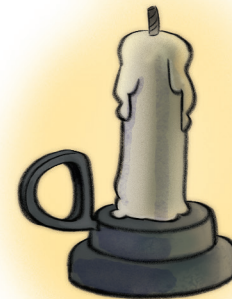
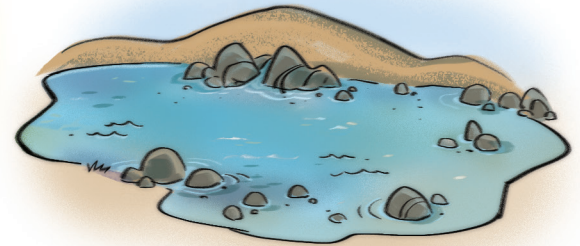
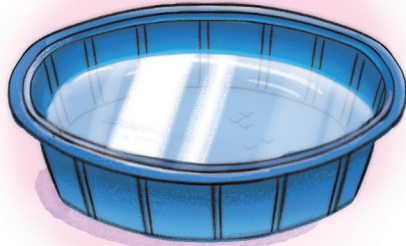


Will It Catch Fire?

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- King Ahab was an evil man who led the people to worship a false god named Baal.
- The false prophets cried out to Baal to send fire on the altar, but Baal did not answer.
- Elijah drenched the altar in water and prayed to the one true God. God sent fire from heaven that burned up everything on the altar, including the water.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

The one true God is not like the false gods. We do not have to work hard to show God we love Him. Instead, He showed His love for us by sending His Son, Jesus. Jesus died to rescue us from sin, and He hears us when we cry out to Him.
