Peter Learned That Jesus Is for All

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Cornelius loved God. One day, an angel told Cornelius to send some men into the city to find Peter.
- In the city, Peter saw a vision. He saw a big sheet coming down from heaven with all kinds of animals. A voice said, “God has made these clean.”
- The men found Peter and invited him to Cornelius’ house. When Peter saw Cornelius, he told him good news: Jesus is for all people.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

God showed Peter that the good news about Jesus is for everyone. God wants believers to tell everyone the good news about Jesus no matter who they are or what they do. Jesus is the Lord of all.

KEY PASSAGE:

1 Corinthians 12:12

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

What is the church? The church is all Christians everywhere.

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Acts 10

Family Discussion Starters:

- What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- What is prayer?
- Who told Cornelius that God heard his prayer?
- Who is someone our family can pray for and invite to church?

Family Activities:

- Enlist your children to help put fresh sheets on everyone's bed. Talk about how Peter saw a big sheet with animals in it coming down from heaven in his vision.
- Celebrate the differences in God's creation by having a buffet of different meats, fruits, and vegetables for family dinner. Try to find items that your preschooler might not have tasted before. As you enjoy the meal together, talk about the differences we see in God's creation. Remind your preschooler that God loves all people equally and wants everyone to hear the good news about Jesus!
