



BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- The prophet Isaiah shared a message about God's promise to send a Rescuer.
- Isaiah said God would keep His promise by sending a child, and the child would be a king.
- Isaiah said the king would be named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.
- Jesus would be a good, fair, and loving King who reigns forever.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

God keeps His promises. God sent His Son, Jesus, into the world as a baby. Jesus saves sinners.

KEY PASSAGE PHRASE:

God keeps His promises. Numbers 23:19

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

Does God keep His promises? Yes, God always keeps His promises.

Family Discussion Starters:

- · What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- Can you name some of the names for Jesus you heard in the Bible story?
- ·Why do you think God sent His Son to earth as a baby and not a grown up?
- ·Who did God send to keep His promise to save the world from sin?

Family Activities:

- •Look up Isaiah 9:6 and talk about the names for Jesus listed in the verse. Work together to make a paper chain of Jesus' names with an adult or older child writing the names on separate paper strips. Show your preschooler how to loop the strips together and secure with tape.
- Make a promise to your kids this week and keep it. You may promise to take them out for a sweet treat, watch a special movie together as a family, or plan an outing with friends. Talk about how people often fail to keep their promises, but God always keeps His promises.
