BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Moses went up a mountain to talk to God.
- God made a covenant, or special agreement, with His people.
- God gave Moses the Ten Commandments.
- The first four commandments told the people how to love and obey God.
- The last six commandments told how to love one another.
- God wrote the commandments on two stone tablets.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

God's rules are good, but people cannot obey them perfectly.
Only Jesus obeyed God
perfectly. We can trust Him to forgive our sin.

KEY PASSAGE PHRASE:

Let's worship God. Psalm 95:6

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

What is worship? Worship is singing, praying, and listening to God.

Family Discussion Starters:

- · What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- \cdot What is one of the Ten Commandments God gave His people?
- · Why are God's rules better than any other rules?
- · Who is the only One who obeyed all of God's rules perfectly?

Family Activities:

- Memorize the Ten Commandments as a family. Use this kid-friendly wording: Do not worship anyone but Me. Do not make statues to worship. Do not treat My name like it is not special. Remember the day of rest. Obey your mother and father. Do not murder. Keep your marriage promises. Do not steal. Do not lie. Do not want things that belong to other people.
- •As you discipline your kids this week, remind them that none of us can obey perfectly because we all sin and make wrong choices. Remind your children that they need Jesus to save them from sin. Pray with your children, asking God to help them obey.
