BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- God told Moses how to build a tabernacle, a tent church.
- The people gave supplies, and they worked together to build the tabernacle.
- Every part of the tabernacle was special.
- Aaron and his sons served God as priests.
- God covered the tabernacle in a cloud. When the cloud moved, the people would move and take the tabernacle with them.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

God's people built a tabernacle where they could worship God together. God wants to be with us. God sent Jesus to earth to be with people.

KEY PASSAGE PHRASE:

Let's worship God. Psalm 95:6

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

What is worship? Worship is singing, praying, and listening to God.

Family Discussion Starters:

- What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- What are some of the items the Israelites used to build the tabernacle?
- Why do you think God wanted His people to make a tabernacle they could pick up and move?
- God wanted to be with His people, so He had them build a tabernacle. Who did God send to earth so we can be with Him forever?

Family Activities:

- Use sheet, chairs, furniture, and any other household items on hand to build a tabernacle as a family. Sit in the tabernacle and read Exodus 40:34-38 together. Review the Bible story.
- Read portions of Exodus 37. Use play dough or other craft supplies to make some of the furniture that was in the tabernacle. Talk about how each part of the tabernacle was special.
