- God gave some craftsmen special talents for building, and His glory filled the tabernacle when it was finished.

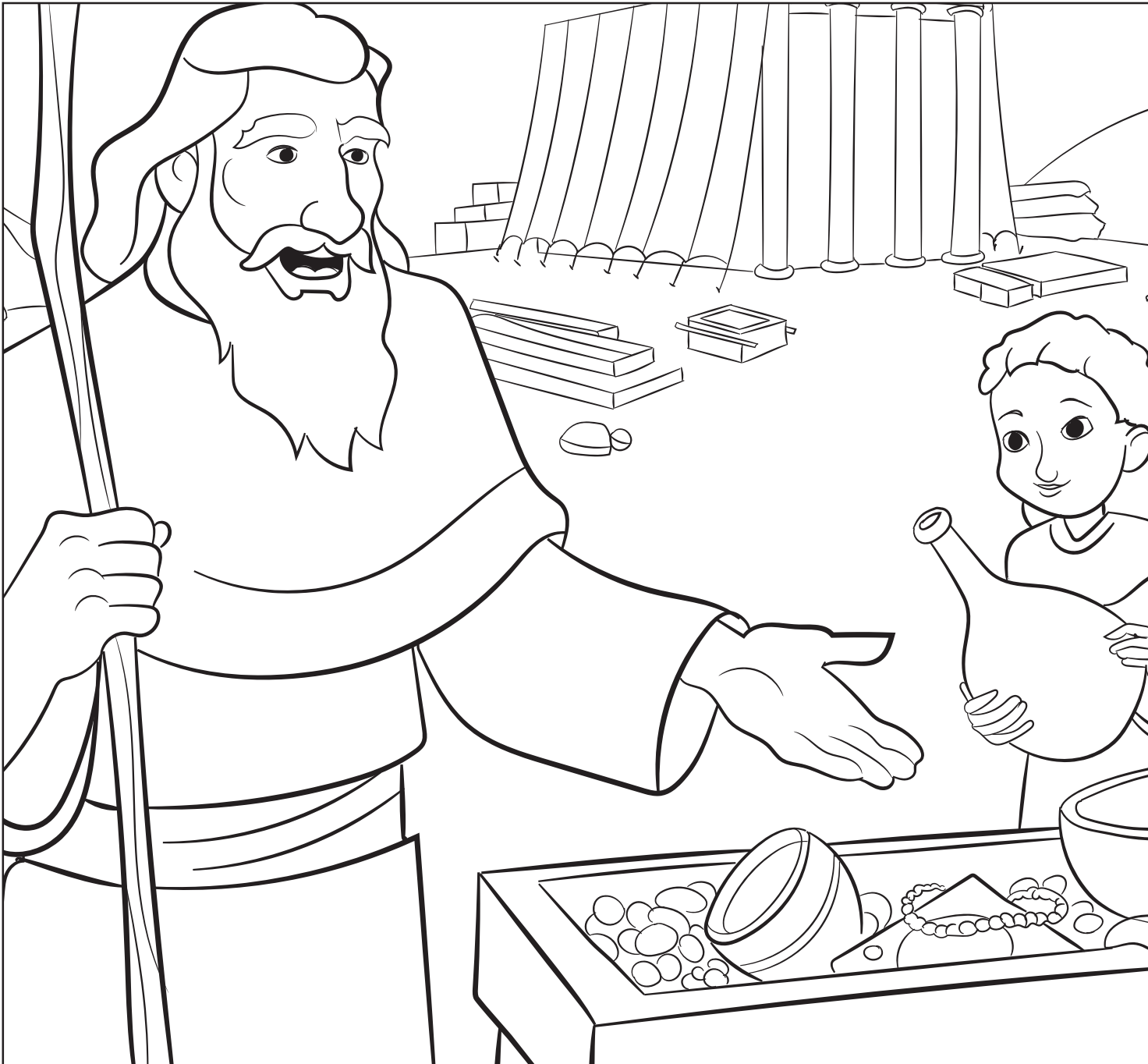
CHRIST CONNECTION:

Family Discussion Starters:

Family Activity:

Ask your kids to help you set up the tent, and use the time to talk about the reasons God instructed His people to build the tabernacle, such as their need for a portable place to meet with Him. Ask your kids to talk about the pros and cons of meeting with God in a tent.
